

Candidate's Card

Read the scenario below. Make any notes you wish to make on a piece of paper.

You are talking to your Spanish friend about your holiday.

The researcher will play the part of your friend.

The researcher will speak first.

You should address the researcher as **'tú'**.

1. Say where you went on holiday.
2. Say you traveled by plane and car.
3. Say one thing you did do and one thing you did not do on holiday.
4. Say that you would like to go to Spain next year.
5. Ask your friend where they are going on holiday this year.
6. Ask your friend something about their last holiday.

Researcher's Card

PLEASE STRICTLY FOLLOW THE SCRIPT BELOW AND READ THE QUESTIONS SLOWLY.

Ask the participant each of the cues below ***twice, with a one second break between each time***. If the participant does not respond to the cue, wait five seconds, and then ask the paraphrased cue [in squared brackets] ***once***.

So, let's start the role play task. It's OK if you don't understand the question. We can just move onto the next one.

1. ¿A dónde fuiste de vacaciones?

[¿ Dónde pasaste las vacaciones ?]

2. ¡ Excelente ! / ¡ Fantástico ! / ¡ Genial ! ¿Cómo viajaste ?

[¿Qué medio de transporte usaste?]

3. ¿ Qué hiciste en las vacaciones ?

[¿ Qué actividades hiciste en las vacaciones?]

4. ¡ Excelente ! ¿Dónde te gustaría ir de vacaciones el año que viene?

[¿Dónde te gustaría ir de vacaciones el próximo año?]

5. ¡ Interesante !

Wait five seconds for the candidate to ask a question. If the candidate does not ask a question after five seconds, say the cue below.

6. ¿ Tienes alguna pregunta ?

Let the candidate respond.

[¿ Alguna pregunta?]

Let the candidate respond.

7. [Give an appropriate but **very simple** response]

Wait for the candidate to ask another question. If the candidate does not ask a question after five seconds, say the cue below.

8. ¿ Tienes alguna pregunta más ?

Let the candidate respond.

[¿ Alguna otra pregunta?]

Let the candidate respond.

9. [Give an appropriate **but very simple** response].

That's brilliant - thank you. Now let's move onto the picture description task.
