and followed Him.



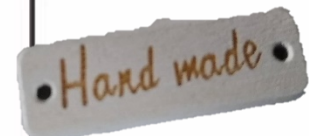
Ezekial 37:4-5

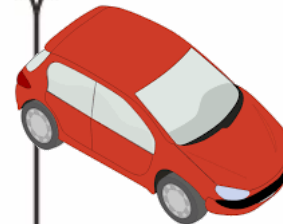
Genesis 1:21

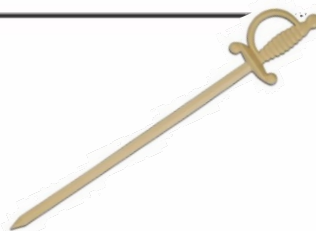
Matthew 16:19

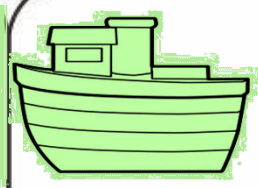
Psalm 34:13
