- 2 hours of rehearsal and decorating day prior to wedding
- 4 hours use of facilities (preparations, ceremony and pictures (additional time \$50- \$100/hr))
- Chapel is setup to seat 200 guests (144 plastic folding chairs, 11 6ft-8ft pews), additional seating is available at an additional cost.
- Microphones with sound system to play your music (audio receiver)
- Separate cabins for bride and groom and their wedding party

- All vehicles must be parked in the back parking lot, no parking in between cabins or on the grass.
- No food or drink allowed in the chapel (water only) unless other arrangements have been made.
- No rice, confetti, bird seed or open flames.
- No nails or screws are allowed to be used in any buildings.
- Any flower petals or other large debris must be swept up prior to departure.
- Dogs are allowed only if on a leash and must be approved by a board member. Dogs must stay with their owners at all times, clean-up is the responsibility of the pet owner.
- The buildings and grounds must be left in the conditions they were when you arrived. All clean-up (chapel, cabins) is your responsibility, a checklist will be provided. All buildings must be swept and trash taken to dumpster prior to departure.
