Step #1: Sign Out of iCloud on Your Macbook:



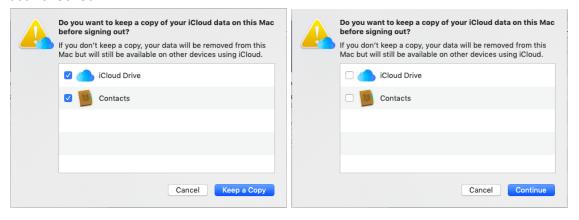
1. Open System Preferences.



- 2. Click on the iCloud icon.
- Check which account you are signed in with. If you are signed in with your pulaski###@pulaskischools.org account...uncheck all boxes next to iCloud Drive, Photos, Mail, etc., and then click Sign Out at the bottom.



4. You can decide if you want to keep a copy of the items listed on your Mac. Leave them checked and click Keep a Copy or uncheck them and click Continue. If you are unsure what to select, leave them both checked.

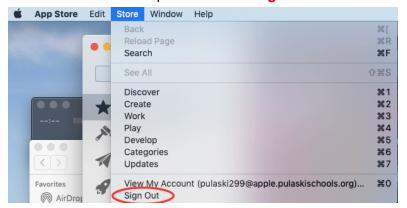


5. Enter your Apple ID password and click **Continue**. You are now signed out of iCloud.

- 2. Click the Store menu option and click Sign Out at the bottom.

Step #3: Optional - Signing into iTunes

You do not to sign into iTunes. From now on, you will be downloading all apps from Self Service.

You will need to complete this before Step#4 if you want to do this.

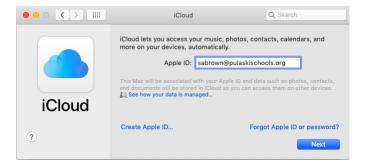
Step #4: Log Into iCloud on Your MacBook



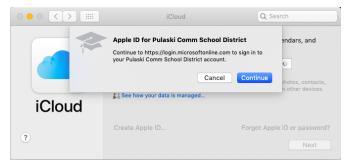
1. Open System Preferences.
