

Summer Fellowship 2025 Training Descriptions

Block 1:

- “The Jedi Archive: Insight through Analytics” in the **Dining Hall** (Nathan Schooler)
 - Gauging Social Media Effectiveness
 - This training is designed to help you run Order of the Arrow social media accounts effectively and with purpose. It covers which platforms to use, how to create engaging and meaningful content, and ways to grow and interact with your audience. By the end, you’ll feel more confident using social media to promote lodge events and strengthen your lodge’s online presence.
- “Using the Force: A Leader’s Mind” at **Webster Lodge** (Michael Esimio)
 - The Psychology of Leadership
 - This training explores the psychological concepts that impact leadership, including how the brain responds under stress and how leaders influence group behavior. It also covers nonverbal communication, emotional regulation, and key factors that affect motivation and decision-making in teams.
- “Padawan’s Path” in **Lekau Lodge** (Daniel Seibel)
 - New Arrowman Introduction
 - In this training, newly inducted Arrowmen will learn how our lodge works, as well as how to get involved in different committees, what each committee does, and their purpose. We will have about a 15 minute Q&A session, as well as time during the training to engage and ask questions about our lodge. Any arrowmen who got inducted in the Spring, or who seeks to get more involved, should definitely attend this training.

Block 2:

- “Echoes of the Force: Remaining Present in the Order” in **Lekau Lodge** (Laila Labib)
 - Staying Engaged in the OA during College

- Many arrowmen face the challenge of managing staying involved and going off to college the same time as going off to college. Through this training, arrowmen will learn tips and methods to balance the switch from High School life while being in the OA to college life while being in the OA.
- “The Jedi Path: Beyond the Council” in the **Dining Hall** (Ben Jones)
 - Getting Involved Outside the Lodge
 - Even though there are many ways to just get involved in your Lodge, there are ways to get involved in the Order of the Arrow which aren’t specific to Lenape Lodge. In this training, Arrowmen will learn what these ways are and how to apply them. This session will aim to develop the next generation of leaders in our Order.

Block 3:

- “A Pilot’s Introduction to Star Fighters” at **Lekau Field** (Joey Pessolano)
 - In this training, you’ll learn about the intricacies of piloting an X-Wing or TIE Fighter, which are then related to real life aircraft! We’ll discuss the lore behind the X-Wing & Tie Fighter, how to pilot them, and how they relate to real planes like the F-35 Lighting II & the MiG-21. Don’t miss out on this exciting and unique opportunity to learn more about the world of STAR WARS space ships!
- “The Art of the Story” at **Webster Lodge** (Gavin Tarditi)
 - There are plenty of complex and extreme special effects that go into any movie, especially Star Wars. In this training, you will learn about the techniques and cutting-edge special effects that went into the development of the Star Wars movies. As well as develop your own short film using different techniques and methods of production.
