

If my student is coming from a private school...

1. Please make sure to register your student for GCS/Page in SchoolMint here: <https://www.gcsnc.com/Page/72992> (This should be done in March/April). If your student applied to one of our magnet programs (IB/ROTC), you can register after you've been accepted to our program (notification released on April 21). The deadline to accept a magnet offer is April 28, 2023.
2. Please schedule an appointment with your child's counselor in April/May to select courses (you can schedule an appointment before completing the SchoolMint registration):

You will need to have on-hand a copy of your student's 6th and 7th grade report cards, as well as their most current report card (you are also welcome to email it to the counselor ahead of time). If your student has a 504 or IEP, please let us know.

3. Your student will be in our system after July 1st as long as all needed forms are submitted (proof of address, immunization records, etc.). At this time, you will want to make sure your student is registered for lunch if needed.

4. Schedules will be sent out in August to students. Freshmen will receive theirs at freshmen orientation.

If my student is districted to another GCS high school but is coming to Page for the ROTC/IB magnet program...

1. Accept the magnet offer in SchoolMint
2. Schedule an appointment with your student's counselor to select courses for next year (please have a copy of report cards/transcripts awarding high school credit on hand).
3. Please refer to steps 3 & 4 above.

If my student is coming from an out of county school...

Please complete all the same steps as the private school students. Any NC records will transfer to us, but it may take several weeks before we have access, so it is helpful if you still have academic records and IEP/504 plans available when meeting with the counselor.

If my student is coming from an out of state school...

Please follow the steps for the private school students. It is important that you send to the counselor any transcripts awarding high school credit.

If it is summer...

Please follow the steps listed above, but instead of emailing your student's respective counselor, please call Page at 336-370-8200 and ask to speak to the counselor on duty about registering your student for classes in the fall.
