████████████████████, also known by his alias "Alexander Montgomery", was hired into the foundation as an ex-GOC operative, after incident [#046554-FG], after ██████████
████████████████████ the following an investigation into CI activities within ██████████,

██████ leading to 15 arrests, and two CI terror cells being destroyed. "Alexander Montgomery", an expert operative specializing in termination trials, and ██████████ of ██████████ ██████████. However after the incident [#046554-FG], "Alexander Montgomery" decided to remain as a Sergeant within the General Security Department at Site-██████ after ██████████ ██████████ ██████████.

After █ years of working under Captain ██████████ "████████", "Alexander Montgomery" requested that Site-██████'s Site-Administration Department be transferred to research, where he started as a Sr. Researcher, due to his CL3 clearance.

Mainly working around SCP-914, and SCP-██████, "Alexander Montgomery" enjoyed working as a researcher, as it allowed him to be curious, and interested in his line of work. Working closely alongside Executive Research ██████████ ██████████ and Sr. Researcher ██████████ ██████████, "Alexander Montgomery" created several high-quality SCP documents, analyzing his predictions on possible future test outcomes, and the possibilities of the SCP usage, if it ever got into another GOI's hands, something that has been very useful, after a raid on Site-██████.

A Chaos-Insurgency splinter cell initiated an attack on Site-██████, taking SCP-██████, and an instance of SCP-██████. Using "Alexander Montgomery" previous analysis, the foundation was able to prevent a possible mass-information breach, by stopping CI from leaking pictures of SCP-██████ by using a coordinated foundation ██████████ ██████████ ██████████ ██████████ ██████████, removing all images of SCP-██████ from the internet, and preventing any more from being uploaded. This caused "Alexander Montgomery" to be commended for his research by Executive Research ██████████ ██████████ and RAISA officers.

"Alexander Montgomery" also showed his worth to the foundation after the Incident [#583584-FG].

Incident Report - #583584-FG

During a breach at Site-██████, SCP-██████, SCP-██████, and SCP-173 breached containment, leading to mass hysteria around the site. Avoiding recommendations, "Alexander Montgomery" prevented several casualties by fighting off escaped D-Class, and assisting in re-containment of SCP-██████.

Because of his quick thinking and brave actions, "Alexander Montgomery" selflessly prevented more unnecessary deaths by helping others get to the Site-██████'s breach shelter, even running back to help an injured researcher, someone he never met because they worked in different departments. These kinds of actions are not something you see from most researchers, and his prior battle experience should be something that is of worth to the foundation.

Incident report - #046554-FG

A small team of GOC operatives embarked on a mission ██████████, ██████████ to neutralize a suspected anomaly trafficking operation. Intelligence had indicated that the Chaos Insurgency (CI) was trafficking anomalous objects. The GOC

operatives, led by Agent [REDACTED].

The GOC had received intel that the Chaos Insurgency was transporting many dangerous anomalous items in a small convoy, something that could be easily ambushed, and destroyed. A small group of [REDACTED] operatives were first sent out to scout the area, including "Alexander Montgomery", however, the situation quickly went south.

25 Chaos-Insurgency standard issue class-[REDACTED] [REDACTED] vehicles were in the convoy, something that over-shot the operation's manpower. CI, using thermal vision scout drones, quickly spotted the GOC operatives, and opened fire, wounding and injuring [REDACTED] the [REDACTED] personnel.

The distress beacon sent out by the operatives was intercepted by the foundation, sending two [REDACTED] helicopters, and MTF Nu-7 to investigate and stop the conflict. After arrival, Both [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] were already declared dead on-seen, leaving [REDACTED] GOC operatives, still under heavy fire with a limited supply of ammunition and food.

MTF Nu-7 arrived on-seen at [REDACTED] hours, on [REDACTED]/[REDACTED]/[REDACTED], adding suppressive fire to the GOC operatives, and taking them back to the Site-[REDACTED] for interrogation and medical treatment.

"Tyron Tiggles" was [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] personnel, and as such [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] CI Convoy, eventually leading to an [REDACTED]-[REDACTED], [REDACTED] the convoy and capture of 17 SCP Objects, labeled:

After this incident, leading the GOC to believe that all operatives were deceased, "Alexander Montgomery" was hired into the foundation as an MTF Operative, however later moved on to work as a GSD Sergeant.
