This program also serves people in special situations, such as those discharged from a psychiatric hospital or incarcerated, those involved with other health and human services agencies, or those who have experienced treatment failures in the public mental health system. The goals of this program are to improve clients' mental health and help them increase their adaptability by functioning in the community. Most staff members are bilingual in Spanish and English or Vietnamese and English. Translation services are available through Language Línea.

Private insurance is not accepted but the program accepts Maryland Medical Assistance, PAC and Medicare. A sliding

fee scale issued by the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Health is used to determine rates; however, customers they are not rejected for not being able to pay.

Low-income montgomery county residents over the age of 18 who have a serious mental illness. Those with private insurance are not eligible. All referrals are through the Access to Behavioral Health Services program.
