

PCMS PTO Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 8:33 a.m.

Steven Shane thanked all of the volunteers at PCMS for their time this past year.

Treasurer's Report: Michele Duvall covered the highlights of the year while going through all of the PTO [income and expenses](#). We had a total income of \$24510.99 with expenditures for students totalling \$5575.81 and teachers totalling \$12768.06. Dr. Lorenz commented that the PTO recognizes both the academic and social needs of its students.

Principal's Report: Dr. Lorenz announced that there will be a small Assistant Principal focus group on Wednesday, May 14, 2025, from 3:30-8:30 p.m. There were 50-60 applicants for the position. After reading through paper applications, the pool was narrowed down to 12-15, and then Zoom interviews were conducted. She asked the PTO for \$150 for each of the 8 academies and teams (totaling \$1200) to support the Building Leadership team. She announced that there will be 9 new staff members, all of which have approximately 5 years of teaching experience. She requested that each of them receive an Amazon gift card for their classroom. Dr. Lorenz also announced that KathyWallace (the school nurse) would be retiring this year, and the current prospect to replace her is a Parkway parent. All eighth graders will walk the building on May 27 at the end of the school day for a clap out prior to eighth grade celebration. Dr. Lorenz commented that this is the best PTO she has ever worked with in her career.

Elections: PCMS PTO is still looking for someone to fill in as an assistant treasurer to shadow Michele Duvall this coming school year. The following officers were nominated and the slate was approved unanimously.
