White polo	Material too hot and heavy	Change material to be lightweight and breathable

Blue uniform shorts (boys)	Length is too long. Fit proportion is off.	Change design. Develop an SAS sizing chart for consistency across pieces.

Blue uniform shorts (boys)	Buttons are problematic for young learners	Eliminate buttons for young learners

PE red tops	Difficult to enforce and manage. What's the purpose of a separate PE kit?	Eliminate PE uniforms and allow regular uniforms to be worn
PE red tops	Fabric is hot, heavy, and retains sweat (smell)	Eliminate PE uniforms and allow regular uniforms to be worn
PE blue shorts	Drawstrings are problematic for young students	Eliminate drawstrings for young learners
PE blue shorts	Length and style is "one size fits all"	Eliminate PE uniforms and have choice of bottoms for regular uniform
Other: House shirt	Hot and heavy	No changes for now
Other: Dress code enforcement	Dress Code rules and enforcement practices are inconsistent and unclear	Simplify and clarify rules and practices across the school and within each division
Other: Sun protection	There are no dress code options beyond sweatshirts that protect against sun exposure	Include light-weight and long-sleeve shirts and pants as uniform options Offer a dress code-approved hat
