4. If needed, go to the ACT website or the College Board website and send in test scores.

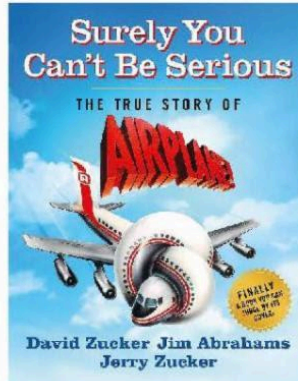
