Can I just have one treatment?

How do I know if I have a roach infestation?

Roaches are nocturnal, so you probably won't see many during the day. At night, go into the kitchen and turn on the light. If you see roaches scatter, you have a larger infestation. If you see more than one roach every week, you have a small infestation that will grow without treatment.

Are cockroaches and roaches dangerous?

Yes, roaches can be dangerous. Roaches can carry disease and bacteria. As they crawl around your kitchen, food, and home, roaches can spread these germs.

Roaches can also crawl into people's ears. **CRAWL INTO YOUR EARS!!!** They then have to be removed by a doctor or nurse to prevent hearing loss or damage.
