

Hoover Elementary Track Meet Parent Information Sheet

When? Monday, April 27th, 2026—4:30 to approx. 8:00 p.m.

Rainout date: Tuesday, April 28th—4:30 p.m.

Who? Any 3rd, 4th, 5th, or 6th grader in the Hoover City School system

Where? Hoover High School Track

Awards? Each finisher/competitor will receive a ribbon for their event. We will not be keeping track of finishing places for individuals or schools.

Costs? There is a \$20 entry fee per student. This will cover the costs of a meet t-shirt, ribbons and entry for all friends and family.

Entry deadline? All entries and entry fees must be received by 11:59 p.m. on Friday, April 17th. This is so t-shirts can be ordered and arrive on time.

Primary Purpose? To expose as many young athletes to the wonderful sport of track and field as possible. Emphasis will be on sportsmanship and striving for the best effort possible for each individual athlete.

Sponsored by? The Finish Line which is the booster club of the Hoover High School track team. All meet officials will be members of the Hoover track team as well as coaches and parents of the high school track athletes.

How do I register? Fill out a registration form and return it to the staff/parent helper from your school. Payments should be made via My School Fees.

Parents access at "Show Student Items", select the "Hoover High School Athletics" school box, then "Show Fees", then "Finish Line Club". If you do not have the school HHS Athletics, they type Hoover where it says "To add a school" then select "Hoover High School Athletics", and proceed as above. Please enter Name of participant; school; t-shirt size and specify youth or adult size (Youth—small, medium, large or Adult—small, medium, large. Complete steps to finalize payments.

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What events are there? See the events sheet on the bottom of this page.

How many events can I do? 3rd graders—maximum of 3 events
4th, 5th, 6th graders—maximum of 4 events

When are the events? See the events time schedule.

Check-In? All athletes should be prepared to check-in to the site of their event 15 minutes prior to the start of their event. An announcement will be made over the PA system for athletes to check-in.

Concessions? Drinks, candy, hot dogs and other various items will be available for purchase at the track.

Uniform? Each athlete should wear the official meet t-shirt provided to you and a pair of shorts of your choosing.
