

Island Instructions: Unit 5, Activity 3

Students Explore Arts Careers on Island 15



Activity Overview:

Island 15 introduces students to careers in arts, part of the STEAMS (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics, and Service/Trade) careers on FQI-E. Information about these careers was adapted from the [My Next Move website](#), developed by the National Center for O*NET Development, under the sponsorship of the US Department of Labor/Employment and Training Administration.

Duration: 20-25 minutes



Island 15 Activity

Instruct students to login to www.fqie.me and visit Island 15. When students arrive on Island 15, they will play the “Guess My Career” game. They will receive up to 3 clues to help them figure out which career is the correct answer.



Once they guess the mystery arts career, they will earn 5 coins for their hut.

Correct! You earned 5 coins!



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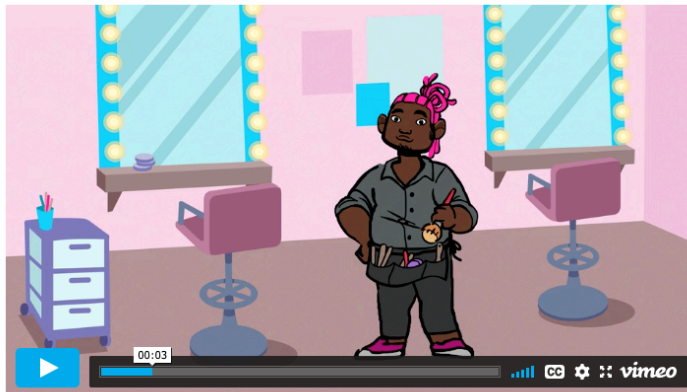
Students Explore Arts Careers on Island 15



Tip! You may want to have students use earbuds/headsets when sound is turned on.



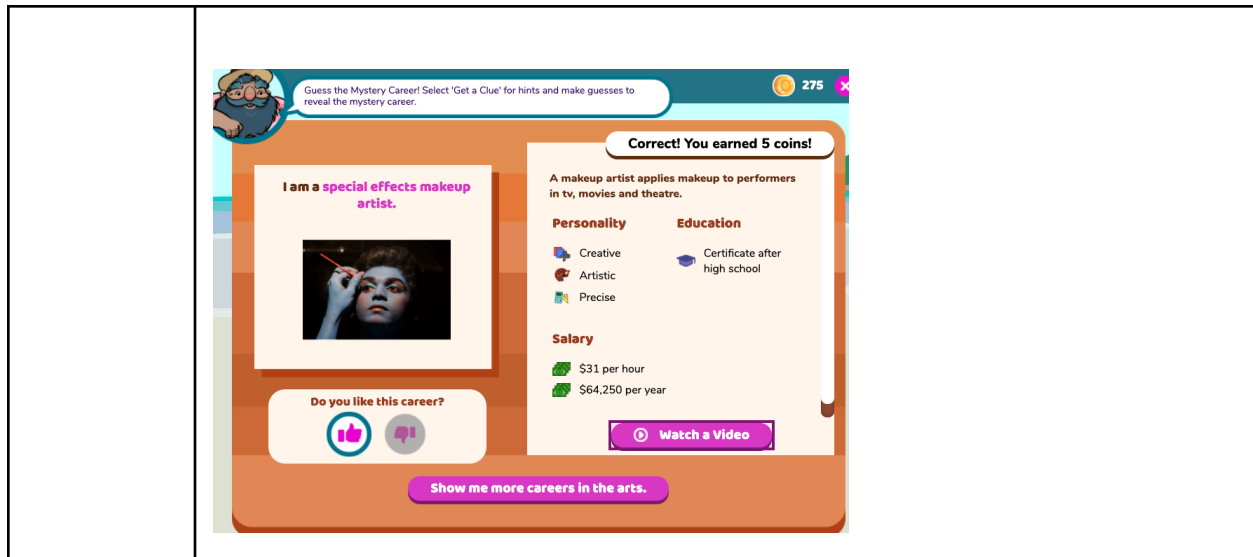
Next, they will be prompted to watch a brief video about the career.



Students can read or listen to details about becoming a makeup artist. They should click the thumbs up or thumbs down button to like or dislike the career.

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When students click on “**Show me more careers in the arts,**” they will be able to view information about personality traits, educational requirements, and average salary for an **architect, music therapist, art teacher, and animator.** Each career has a 15-20 second video and an option for students to click the thumbs up or thumbs down for each career.




Portfolio Writing Prompt
