Art Project Details

Your artist sketchbook will also be submitted as part of your project. Everything that you research, including picture samples should be in your sketchbook. All of this will be judged as part of your art project. Everything should be in your own writing. If you make a mistake, cross it out. Don't erase it. Mistakes and revisions are part of the design process.

Begin by drawing at least two rough sketches of your project in your sketchbook.
Research examples of the art style you are considering, both historical or
contemporary (made now). Take notes of your learning in your sketchbook. Add
pictures from your research.
Research the science connected to your project. This may include:
☐ Techniques
☐ Tools
☐ Materials (clay, chemicals)
☐ Paint types; how different colors are formed with pigments; using oils and
turpentine; how acrylic paint is made
☐ Paper types
☐ Processes involved in creating the piece (heat reactions, chemical
reactions)
☐ Mathematical proportions (golden spiral)

Reflection essay: Write two to three paragraphs summarizing your research, your
process and what you learned.
