The workgroup will use the data to create a report that recommends policy solutions to the House of Representatives and Senate. The report would also include community-based solutions for Washington State residents.

Please support the Deaf, DeafBlind, DeafDisabled, and Hard of Hearing communities in Washington State by lending your support to the passage of this bill.

2. How to find your legislators:

- Find and email your legislators: [Washington State Legislature](#).
 - Input your home address, click “Find My District”
 - You will see a list of Legislators for your district (3 Washington State Legislators and 3 Federal Congressional Legislators)
 - Pick one **State Legislator** to see directory
 - In your Legislator’s profile, click “Email” to see a form
 - Step 1: Input your home address and click “Verify District”
 - Step 2: Input in your contact info
 - Step 3: Go to “Subject” (Skip “Bill Number, “Initiative Number”, “Description”, “Position”)
 - **Subject:** Sign Language Interpreter Shortage
 - **Message:** Copy and paste the Letter of Introduction (remember to edit with your information), or enter your own message
 - **Would you like a response:** Click YES
 - You’ll see a new prompt: “Would you like to send a copy to your email message to other legislators in your district...”
 - Click YES
 - Click on “Send Comment” button
