### NRHA Pattern 7



1. Run at speed to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a left roll back—no hesitation.
2. Run to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
3. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
6. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
7. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
8. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

## Horse Descriptions

1. **Arod (Circle M)** – White QH, Bouncy but can go slower, two hand option, has a lead change.
2. **Asher (M & M)** – Gets slightly forward but very manageable. Feet away to stop, hum to slow. Light contact is best. Set up for right lead but it's usually not much of a problem. Easy lead changes. Soft contact and VOICE to stop. Ask Shauna if unsure what's best option for you. 2 hand option. Ball spurs preferred, but can use rowels if rider is good with legs. Ask Shauna which is best of the day.
3. **Bailey (Bates)** - Bay all around mare. Has a spur stop. Do not trap her, soft hands and keep her slow. 2 hand option. Ball spurs only.
4. **Blackie (Circle M)** – Black QH, spur trained, ball spurs only, medium rein.
5. **Blue (M & M)** – Hum to slow. Very smooth gaits. Set up for leads. Will stay quiet and controlled but rider needs to keep him there or he'll get fast. Optional 1 hand for rail classes, 2 hands for all pattern classes. Division appropriate spurs.
6. **Bob (M & M)** – Very bouncy. Feet away to stop and back. Big lead change. Crop if necessary but probably will not necessary to use it. Division appropriate spurs.
7. **Brutus (EQD)** – Bay/white paint gelding. Old show horse. Knows all the stuff but will not do it unless you make him. Tap legs for quiet jog off, and soft press for lope off. Will set up and sometimes has a delay in his lope departures. Do not poke with spurs or he will get mad. Say easy to make downward transitions better. Medium rein contact. Has a spur stop. Division appropriate spurs.
8. **Cash (Winning Edge)** – Soft, slow hand. 2 hand option and division appropriate spurs.
9. **Chance (Silver Spur)** – Sorrel gelding. Walt/trot only. Very bouncy trot. Super quiet and will get lazy. Close calf and hum to slow. Rides with his head higher, will bridle up. Leg and playing with his bit is the best way. Two hand option. No spurs.
10. **Chase (EQD)** - White/sorrel tovero Paint Gelding. Needs guiding with legs to steers. Soft jog transitions. Set up for leads and support with leg. Can be lazy. Two hand option. Division appropriate spurs
11. **Chili (EQD)** - Sorrel/White Paint Mare. Can be lazy, but has soft slow jog, when asked appropriately. Lope can be slow but will build if allowed. Set up for leads and support with leg. Will bridle up if asked. Two hand option. Ball spurs only.
12. **Cleo (JPH)** - Grey AQHA mare. Division appropriate spurs. One hand squeeze legs to slow down. Older all around/pleasure mare. Very much point and shoot type of draw.
13. **Colby (CNPH)** – AQHA cross – blue roan. Very lazy. Set up for right lead. Use voice and keep leg on at lope. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
14. **Cookie (Winning Edge)** – Do not over bridle. Stay very soft and slow with hand. Leg off and whoa to stop. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
15. **Darlene (EQD)** - Black/White Paint Mare, set up for right lead. Soft hand. Spur stops, collect with leg. Division appropriate spurs.
16. **Dennis (Bates)** – Set up for right lead. Keep hands down to turn. **Lots** of leg. Has a lead change but no sliders. 2 hand option, crop ok and division appropriate spurs.
17. **Dixie (M & M)** – Medium rein. Very easy +10 jog. Hum to slow. Whoa to stop. Light contact to whoa in patterns. Division appropriate spurs.

**18. Dually (JPH)** – Great draw. Uncomplicated reiner. Slightly bend to the inside on fast circles. Division appropriate spurs. Medium contact, one hand.

**19. Ellie (EQD)** - Paint Mare. Pleasure/spur broke, but tends to ride a little more forward in the lope. Soft mouth connection, quiet legs. Soft leg bumps for the jog and use voice commands. Don't poke with spurs. Responds very well to voice commands. Make sure to say "Easy" to get better downward transitions. Has a spur stop. Two hand option. Will do better two handed for patterns but can be one handed. Division appropriate spurs.

**20. Finch (CNPH)** – Sorrel AQHA. Set up for right lead and use voice for transitions. Medium contact. Do not pull. Two hand option. Division appropriate spurs.

**21. Gunner (M & M)** – Very comfortable gaits. Medium speed is better than getting him to go to slow. Light to medium rein contact. Hum and slight leg release to stop. He won't back up or stop if you squeeze. Set up for both leads, especially the left lead. Two hand option.

**22. Gus (Winning Edge)** – Leg off and whoa to stop. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.

**23. Hank (Silver Spur)** – 16H palomino gelding. Solid walk/trot horse. Set up for leads. Medium contact. Has a nice slow relaxed jog. Solid extended trot. Support with calf and he loves vocal cues. Forward in the lope. Likes very quiet confident cues. Two hand option. No spurs.

**24. Holli (M & M)** – Easy lead changes. Stand or post to trot in the ranch. Hum to slow. Correct turns but cannot go super fast. Leg release to stop. VERY rough stop. Suggest ball spurs for rail classes otherwise division appropriate spurs. Two hand option.

**25. Hunter (M & M)** – Has a dressage background. Ride leg to hand. Keep medium contact but ride through your leg. Big, pretty gaits but must keep focused. Squeeze to back. Two hands. Division appropriate spurs.

**26. Jaki (M & M)** – Very good draw. Feet away to stop and back. May give trouble staying on the rail. Can carry a crop if needed. .

**27. Jay (M & M)** –Easy leaded, good turns. Give him a stride to whoa. Say the word and pull, Hum to slow. No spur stop. Will pick head up to the sky when you go in the arena but stays quiet. Tight contact. Two-hands. Ball spurs only (watch for changes on board).

**28. Jerl (Circle M)** – Older reiner, medium rein, division appropriate spurs, has lead change.

**29. Kid (M & M)** – Ranch typey. Set up for right lead. Leg release to stop. Hum to slow. Big strided. Medium to tight rein length but have a giving hand. Two hand option. Division appropriate spur.

**30. Lizzie (M & M)** – Lots of leg. Medium rein. Feet away to stop. Hum to slow. Usually antsy in holding area but great draw. Easy lead changes and turns. Post or stand in posting trot. Division appropriate spurs.

**31. Magoo (CNPH)** – Bay AQHA. Set up for lope transitions. Medium contact to keep framed. Give and release pressure and ride leg to hand. 2 hand option. Ball spurs only.

**32. Max (Circle M)** - Bay QH. Spur trained wp type, slow and easy. Medium rein contact.

**33. Moonie (Bates)** – Ranch horse. Ride with soft contact. Use voice for down transitions and take legs off. Keep forward in turns. Sep up for leads. No lead change. 2 hand option, Ball spurs only.


**34. Nolan (Bates)** – Keep slow with soft contact. Keep forward in turns. Cluck to extend trot. 2 hand option. No spurs.

**35. Norman (M & M)** –Best on a medium rein. Very good lead changes but have to ask HARD. Keep hand forward to turn. Can be lazy. Super simple on the rail. Feet out to back up, hum to slow down. Two hand option in patterns. Crop option if necessary. BIGGEST division appropriate spurs.

36. **Pete (Bates)** – Keep slow and in the bridle. Keep forward in his turns. Crop option. Rowel spurs only.
37. **Phoenix (M & M)** – Keep forward in gaits. Keep focused. Hum to slow. Medium rein. Set up for right lead. Light squeeze to slow. Can be looky on the rail. Keep his attention. Two hand option.
38. **Ralphie (CNPH)** – Red roan AQHA. Set up for left lead. Medium contact with give and release pressure. Use seat to slow. 2 hand option. No spurs.
39. **Rebel (JPH)** – Ball spurs only, tighter rein. Great draw if you keep him collected. One or two hand option. Very easy going.
40. **Riley (EQD)** - Sorrel QH Gelding. Light rein contact. Soft legs. If he wants to go slow, let him. Don't be pushy. - Soft cues for leads and pattern work. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope. Division appropriate spurs, but don't overuse them.
41. **Sam (M & M)** – Usually lazy on the rail but gets “jiggy” sometimes in the pattern. Any rein length on the rail will work. Keep an eye on your left lead. Squeeze to slow, stop and back or just hum and say whoa. Usually takes a lot of leg. Crop option for walk trotters on the rail. Division appropriate spurs.
42. **Sarge (Circle M)** – Ball spurs only, two hand option, support right lead.
43. **Sassy M & M**) – Very basic. Hum to slow, pull to stop and back. Crop if necessary. Division appropriate spurs.
44. **Shotgun (Circle M)** – Reiner, ball spurs. 2 hand option.
45. **Sire (M & M)** – Very easy draw. Leg release to stop, hum to slow. Crop permitted if necessary. Division appropriate spurs.
46. **Smoke (DG)** – Good draw. Can get lazy. Ride leg to hand. Use voice cues. Support with outside leg in lope. “Whoa”, sit and leg off to stop. Crop ok for w/t. Division appropriate spurs.
47. **Sweet Pea (Bates)** – Ride with soft contact. Keep forward in turns. Set up for leads. No lead change. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
48. **Trina (CNPH)** – Silver dapple Gypsy Vanner. Medium contact and use voice for transitions. Will go slow and collected if ridden leg to hand. Soft hands. More sensitive than other gypsies. Division appropriate spurs.
49. **WeBe (DG)** – Use voice and seat – minimal leg. Cluck to jog and whoa to stop. Keep contact. Will get forward in canter. DO NOT cinch – will bite. Two hand option. NO SPURS.

Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.

4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.

5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (threemeters). Hesitate.

6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

## Horse Descriptions

50. **Arod (Circle M)** – White QH, Bouncy but can go slower, two hand option, has a lead change.
51. **Asher (M & M)** – Gets slightly forward but very manageable. Feet away to stop, hum to slow. Light contact is best. Set up for right lead but it's usually not much of a problem. Easy lead changes. Soft contact and VOICE to stop. Ask Shauna if unsure what's best option for you. 2 hand option. Ball spurs preferred, but can use rowels if rider is good with legs. Ask Shauna which is best of the day.
52. **Blackie (Circle M)** – Black QH, spur trained, ball spurs only, medium rein.
53. **Blue (M & M)** – Hum to slow. Very smooth gaits. Set up for leads. Will stay quiet and controlled but rider needs to keep him there or he'll get fast. Optional 1 hand for rail classes, 2 hands for all pattern classes. Division appropriate spurs.
54. **Bob (M & M)** – Very bouncy. Feet away to stop and back. Big lead change. Crop if necessary but probably will not necessary to use it. Division appropriate spurs.
55. **Brutus (EQD)** – Bay/white paint gelding. Old show horse. Knows all the stuff but will not do it unless you make him. Tap legs for quiet jog off, and soft press for lope off. Will set up and sometimes has a delay in his lope departures. Do not poke with spurs or he will get mad. Say easy to make downward transitions better. Medium rein contact. Has a spur stop. Division appropriate spurs.
56. **Cash (Winning Edge)** – Soft, slow hand. 2 hand option and division appropriate spurs.
57. **Chance (Silver Spur)** – Sorrel gelding. Walt/trot only. Very bouncy trot. Super quiet and will get lazy. Close calf and hum to slow. Rides with his head higher, will bridle up. Leg and playing with his bit is the best way. Two hand option. No spurs.
58. **Chase (EQD)** - White/sorrel tovero Paint Gelding. Needs guiding with legs to steers. Soft jog transitions. Set up for leads and support with leg. Can be lazy. Two hand option. Division appropriate spurs
59. **Chili (EQD)** - Sorrel/White Paint Mare. Can be lazy, but has soft slow jog, when asked appropriately. Lope can be slow but will build if allowed. Set up for leads and support with leg. Will bridle up if asked. Two hand option. Ball spurs only.
60. **Cleo (JPH)** - Grey AQHA mare. Division appropriate spurs. One hand squeeze legs to slow down. Older all around/pleasure mare. Very much point and shoot type of draw.
61. **Colby (CNPH)** – AQHA cross – blue roan. Very lazy. Set up for right lead. Use voice and keep leg on at lope. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
62. **Cookie (Winning Edge)** – Do not over bridle. Stay very soft and slow with hand. Leg off and whoa to stop. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
63. **Darlene (EQD)** - Black/White Paint Mare, set up for right lead. Soft hand. Spur stops, collect with leg. Division appropriate spurs.
64. **Dennis (Bates)** – Set up for right lead. Keep hands down to turn. **Lots** of leg. Has a lead change but no sliders. 2 hand option, crop ok and division appropriate spurs.
65. **Dixie (M & M)** – Medium rein. Very easy +10 jog. Hum to slow. Whoa to stop. Light contact to whoa in patterns. Division appropriate spurs.
66. **Dually (JPH)** – Great draw. Uncomplicated reiner. Slightly bend to the inside on fast circles. Division appropriate spurs. Medium contact, one hand.

**67. Ellie (EQD)** - Paint Mare. Pleasure/spur broke, but tends to ride a little more forward in the lope. Soft mouth connection, quiet legs. Soft leg bumps for the jog and use voice commands. Don't poke with spurs. Responds very well to voice commands. Make sure to say "Easy" to get better downward transitions. Has a spur stop. Two hand option. Will do better two handed for patterns but can be one handed. Division appropriate spurs.

**68. Finch (CNPH)** – Sorrel AQHA. Set up for right lead and use voice for transitions. Medium contact. Do not pull. Two hand option. Division appropriate spurs.

**69. Gunner (M & M)** – Very comfortable gaits. Medium speed is better than getting him to go to slow. Light to medium rein contact. Hum and slight leg release to stop. He won't back up or stop if you squeeze. Set up for both leads, especially the left lead. Two hand option.

**70. Gus (Winning Edge)** – Leg off and whoa to stop. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.

**71. Hank (Silver Spur)** – 16H palomino gelding. Solid walk/trot horse. Set up for leads. Medium contact. Has a nice slow relaxed jog. Solid extended trot. Support with calf and he loves vocal cues. Forward in the lope. Likes very quiet confident cues. Two hand option. No spurs.

**72. Holli (M & M)** – Easy lead changes. Stand or post to trot in the ranch. Hum to slow. Correct turns but cannot go super fast. Leg release to stop. VERY rough stop. Suggest ball spurs for rail classes otherwise division appropriate spurs. Two hand option.

**73. Hunter (M & M)** – Has a dressage background. Ride leg to hand. Keep medium contact but ride through your leg. Big, pretty gaits but must keep focused. Squeeze to back. Two hands. Division appropriate spurs.

**74. Jaki (M & M)** – Very good draw. Feet away to stop and back. May give trouble staying on the rail. Can carry a crop if needed. .

**75. Jay (M & M)** –Easy leaded, good turns. Give him a stride to whoa. Say the word and pull, Hum to slow. No spur stop. Will pick head up to the sky when you go in the arena but stays quiet. Tight contact. Two-hands. Ball spurs only (watch for changes on board).

**76. Jerl (Circle M)** – Older reiner, medium rein, division appropriate spurs, has lead change.

**77. Kid (M & M)** – Ranch typey. Set up for right lead. Leg release to stop. Hum to slow. Big strided. Medium to tight rein length but have a giving hand. Two hand option. Division appropriate spur.

**78. Lizzie (M & M)** – Lots of leg. Medium rein. Feet away to stop. Hum to slow. Usually antsy in holding area but great draw. Easy lead changes and turns. Post or stand in posting trot. Division appropriate spurs.

**79. Magoo (CNPH)** – Bay AQHA. Set up for lope transitions. Medium contact to keep framed. Give and release pressure and ride leg to hand. 2 hand option. Ball spurs only.

**80. Max (Circle M)** - Bay QH. Spur trained wp type, slow and easy. Medium rein contact.

**81. Moonie (Bates)** – Ranch horse. Ride with soft contact. Use voice for down transitions and take legs off. Keep forward in turns. Sep up for leads. No lead change. 2 hand option, Ball spurs only.

**82. Nolan (Bates)** – Keep slow with soft contact. Keep forward in turns. Cluck to extend trot. 2 hand option. No spurs.

**83. Norman (M & M)** –Best on a medium rein. Very good lead changes but have to ask HARD. Keep hand forward to turn. Can be lazy. Super simple on the rail. Feet out to back up, hum to slow down. Two hand option in patterns. Crop option if necessary. BIGGEST division appropriate spurs.

**84. Pete (Bates)** – Keep slow and in the bridle. Keep forward in his turns. Crop option. Rowel spurs only.


85. **Phoenix (M & M)** – Keep forward in gaits. Keep focused. Hum to slow. Medium rein. Set up for right lead. Light squeeze to slow. Can be looky on the rail. Keep his attention. Two hand option.
86. **Ralphie (CNPH)** – Red roan AQHA. Set up for left lead. Medium contact with give and release pressure. Use seat to slow. 2 hand option. No spurs.
87. **Rebel (JPH)** - Ball spurs only, tighter rein. Great draw if you keep him collected. One or two hand option. Very easy going.
88. **Riley (EQD)** - Sorrel QH Gelding. Light rein contact. Soft legs. If he wants to go slow, let him. Don't be pushy. - Soft cues for leads and pattern work. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope. Division appropriate spurs, but don't overuse them.
89. **Sam (M & M)** – Usually lazy on the rail but gets "jiggy" sometimes in the pattern. Any rein length on the rail will work. Keep an eye on your left lead. Squeeze to slow, stop and back or just hum and say whoa. Usually takes a lot of leg. Crop option for walk trotters on the rail. Division appropriate spurs.
90. **Sarge (Circle M)** – Ball spurs only, two hand option, support right lead.
91. **Sassy M & M**) – Very basic. Hum to slow, pull to stop and back. Crop if necessary. Division appropriate spurs.
92. **Shotgun (Circle M)** – Reiner, ball spurs. 2 hand option.
93. **Sire (M & M)** – Very easy draw. Leg release to stop, hum to slow. Crop permitted if necessary. Division appropriate spurs.
94. **Smoke (DG)** – Good draw. Can get lazy. Ride leg to hand. Use voice cues. Support with outside leg in lope. "Whoa", sit and leg off to stop. Crop ok for w/t. Division appropriate spurs.
95. **Sweet Pea (Bates)** – Ride with soft contact. Keep forward in turns. Set up for leads. No lead change. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
96. **Trina (CNPH)** – Silver dapple Gypsy Vanner. Medium contact and use voice for transitions. Will go slow and collected if ridden leg to hand. Soft hands. More sensitive than other gypsies. Division appropriate spurs.
97. **WeBe (DG)** – Use voice and seat – minimal leg. Cluck to jog and whoa to stop. Keep contact. Will get forward in canter. DO NOT cinch – will bite. Two hand option. NO SPURS.
