Tidy up (*Recoller/Ordear*). Ex.- Tidy up the garden!

New expressions

Is there a butterfly in your garden? (*Hai unha bolboreta no teu xardín?*) Yes, **there is** / No, **there isn't**

Are there two grasshoppers in the garden? (*Hai dous saltamontes...?*)
Yes, **there are**. / No, **there aren't**

Are there any grasshoppers in the garden? (*Hai algún saltamontes...?*)
Yes, **there are**. / No, **there aren't**

There are some tomatoes in the garden. (*Hai algúns tomates no xardín*)

There are lots of people in the community garden. (*Hai muita xente...*)

Would you like a flower? (*Queres unha flor? Gustaríache unha...?*)
Yes, **please**. / No, **thank you**.

What **are** you doing? (*Qué estás facendo?*)

I **am** feeding the birds (*Estou alimentando os paxaros*)

What **is** Peter doing? He **is** watering the plants.

I **have got** a greenhouse / She **has got** a garden.

What **is** your favourite animal?

This **is** my favourite animal.

I **like** reading (*Gústame ler*)

I **like** books about animals (*Gústanme os libros sobre animais*)

It **is** short and strong (*É pequen@ e forte*)

It **'s got** four legs. (*Ten catro patas*)

Is it strong? Yes, it **is** / No, it **isn't**

There is a snail (*Hai un caracol*)

There are two snails (*Hai dous caracois*)

Where is it? It **is** in the garden. (*Onde está? Está no xardín*)
