Hello Briggs and Cardinal Elementary Families!

Your student will be bringing home their Virtual Learning Packet today. Please locate this packet in your student's backpack/belongings and take it out to be kept at home in a safe place.

As Superintendent Notz shared in her Virtual Learning Family Letter, a district committee has been working on creating a virtual learning plan to use for inclement weather days once we have used our "extra" hours within our calendar and after adding one in-person day to the end of the school year. This means that if we get to a point where we are not meeting our 1,080 required school hours (four snow days or a combination of full snow days and early outs/late starts), we will begin using virtual learning days.

Upon the announcement of a school closure due to weather, Superintendent Notz will inform families if that day will be a Virtual Learning Day (Day 1, Day 2, Day 3, Day 4, or Day 5); if so, your student should utilize the materials in their Virtual Learning Packet for that day. In order for your elementary child's attendance to be marked "present" for a Virtual Learning Day, they are required to return the "Must Do" activities for the Day to their teacher on the next in-school day.
