In the last couple years I found that learning about and uncovering unreleased or unseen footage from games has been an interesting pastime for me, I've found the discovery of that kind of stuff incredibly fascinating, seeing what we never got to see, and a lot of the time these days I've found myself finding the pre-release content of sonic games to be the most interesting to dig the past of.

With this information I knew I had to keep looking, it was too tantalizing, I felt like I had discovered something immensely substantial and Sonic Riders was actually one of my favourite games from my childhood, but when I kept on searching, I wasn't prepared for the piece of gaming history I found next.

On the same Forum I had found the concept art of Xtreme on, I had found a rom of a pre-release beta of Sonic Riders that claimed to not only have unreleased tracks and multiplayer characters, but even featured Xtreme the Vulture as an actual racer. When i saw this i was ecstatic, this is a major find, so without thinking i decided to download the rom.

When i opened it, it just booted to a crude version of the main title screen, its obvious this was a purely unfinalized version of the game itself so i wasn't surprised, but what did surprise me was when i continued, it booted me straight to a character select, and in the menu itself there were of course the usual sonic riders characters minus the babylon rogues, but rouge, shadow and cream were also unlocked, and there were even some racers not playable in the game at all, some listed were Omega, Big, Blaze, all the members of the Chaotix and weirdest of all Silver was there too, which I wouldn't expect seeing how the game came out the same year as 06, maybe they suspected he would do well as a character initially and wanted him in but decided against it. I started the race and it was just normal other than a few things; The track didn't feature any hazards and a lot of its appearance seemed very unpolished, but it didn't matter, I was still familiar with the track itself so I kept on racing.

I completed the first 2 laps with zero issue and was just about to cross the finish line of the final lap, but as i got to the finish line, i saw it, something suddenly rushed past me and crossed the finish line, and my game froze.
