Audio Elements	Observations
Example: Background music	<i>Comedic music or scary music</i>
a. Background (music)	
b. Sound effects (door creaks, footsteps)	
c. Voiceovers (recorded narration)	
d. Dialogue (recorded conversations)	
e. Ambient noise (like wind blowing)	
f. Musical sting (sound that punctuates the moment)	
g. Silence/pause (absence of sound)
