Thank you for signing Complete Streets legislation, the Cumulative Impacts law, and the PFAS ban. As a street safety and climate voter, these laws are very important to me.

When you first became governor, you promised to listen to the legislature and to the people. Please withdraw your nomination of Hector LaSalle.

We need a chief judge like Edwina Richardson-Mendelson, Abbe Gluck, or Corey Stoughton, who will stand up for New Yorkers in the face of an increasingly hostile, right-wing Supreme Court and who will defend reproductive justice, workers' rights, and due process for all New Yorkers.

I am also writing to urge you to direct the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance to grant a waiver to NYC to suspend recertification requirements for SNAP benefits.

While the OTDA reasonably insists that the city's Human Resources Administration must fill the thousands of staff vacancies that have caused the backlog, your administration cannot stand by as people go hungry.

OTDA must grant the waiver, create a corrective action plan for HRA, and publish specific data on new applicants, recertifications and delays across New York City and state. Please take action immediately to address this crisis.
