Class violations

Class 1- verbal warning, potential fine

Class 2-Mandatory fine, potential suspension

Class 3-Suspension pending IA investigation, potential termination

Documentation of violations will be required and enforced by all Lieutenants and above If you have 3 or more Class 1 violations you will be suspended

If you have 2 or more Class 2 violations you will be suspended and will be possibly relieved of duty

If you have a Class 3 violation and you get any other violations after that will result in immediate dismissal

Road violations

- Road violations are a class one violation
 - Reckless driving
 - Speeding
 - Ramming other cars without permission to pit maneuver(class 2 but not limited to)
- Code 1 (no speeding in excess of the speed limits, no lights, no sirens)
 - Call to reception
 - Picking an officer up for duty
 - Returning to HQ from DOC
- Code 2 (limit of 70kmh over the established speed limits, lights, no sirens)
 - Transporting a prisoner
 - Responding to non-violent calls
 - Active search
- Code 3 (no limit on speed must have lights and sirens on)
 - Robbery/Raid events
 - Global and Local reinforcement calls

- Responding to a violent call
- Active pursuit

Radio edditic

- Improper use of radio communications is a class one violation
- Using work radio for private matters is a class 2 violation
- Using work radio instead of local talk is a class 1 violation

Professional violations

- Civilian task while on duty is prohibited and is a class two violation
- Mistreatment of a civilian or any government employees is a class 3 violation
- Unnecessary escalation of a situation is a class 2 violation but not limited to
- Failure to lock doors and gates is a class 1 violation but not limited to
- Farming The Casino and Farm and farm for parking tickets is a class 1 violation
- Standing outside HQ for the sole purpose of insurance is a class 1 violation
- Mistreatment of a fellow officer is a class 2 violation but not limited to
- Failure to compile with dress code is a class 1 violation

Maintaining state property

- Parking of SAHP vehicle in public spaces is prohibited and is a class two violation
- Destruction of State vehicles is a class two violation
- Failure to return a State vehicle in acceptable condition is a class one violation
 - o gas in the tank
 - no large repairs needed
- Failure to maintain gear is a class two violation
 - Spawning in a location that will void equipment
 - Dropping department issued gear

Maintaining logs and Reports

- Failure to maintain duty logs is a class 1 violation
- Failure to maintain arrest logs is a class 2 violation
- Failure to maintain a body cam for an arrest is a class 2 violation but not limited to
- Failure to report a robbery of government property is a class 2 violation but not limited to

Inactivity

- Failure to arrive at basic training within 10 days will result in termination
- Missing 5 training opportunities for promotion in Deputy status without cause is a class 3 violation
- Going AFK for more than 10 minutes without going off duty is a class 1 violation
- Failure to fill out an LOA if your going to be absent for more than 3 days is a class 1 violation but not limited to

Chain of Command

• Failure to abide by established COC is a class 2 violation

• Failure to abide by a direct order from superior officer is a class 2 violation

Violation Correction Procedure

- Another officer of rank LT or higher must be brought-in and present, during all interactions from the violation
- Bodycam must be active
- Violator must be present
- Internal Corrective Measures Form must be completed immediately after corrective measures
