FAOs About Kindergarten

- 1. When is kindergarten registration?
 - a. Registration opens in March at <u>www.kingslocal.net</u>. You will register online through a platform called Final Forms. To find the link on the website, click on Departments. Under Departments, select Registration. Follow the instructions.
- 2. What supplies will my child need?
 - a. Supply lists will be created in the spring and available on each school's web page located on the district's website.
- 3. How many students are in a kindergarten class?
 - a. Class sizes are between 20 and 25 students. This number varies based on student enrollment.
- 4. When does school begin?
 - a. Check the district's website for the school year's academic calendar for start dates.
- 5. What does bussing look like for kindergartners?
 - a. Our youngest students sit toward the front of the bus. There are no aides on the bus unless a child specifically needs one. Kindergarten students are dismissed first. Teachers walk students to their buses at dismissal.
- 6. When will we find out about our child's bus route?
 - a. Transportation typically has that available a week before school starts. You will
 be able to find out this information on the district's website. Click on Departments,
 Transportation, and look for this:

- 7. Will there be a kindergarten orientation?
 - a. Yes! Each building will hold kindergarten orientation in August. Students will get to tour the building, take a small bus ride, and participate in a short activity in the classroom.
- 8. How do I know if my child is ready for kindergarten?
 - a. All children are met at their level of learning when they begin school. You can find helpful resources on the <u>Kings Early Childhood</u> webpage.
 - b. Ohio's Early Learning and Development Standards provide a comprehensive set of expectations that describe what a child should know and be able to do by the end of their preschool experience.
- 9. Will I be able to choose my teacher?
 - c. There is an opportunity to describe your child's personality and what works best for them when completing the Final Forms documents. This information is taken into consideration when placing children with teachers.
 - 9. When can I register for Before and After Kings Kids Childcare and summer camp?
 - a. Summer Camp Registration is in February.
 - b. Before and After school care registration is in March.
