

PhD Admission in Mathematics – IIIT-Delhi

Applications are invited from dedicated and self-motivated candidates for admission into the PhD program in Mathematics. Selected candidates will conduct research with Prof. Anuradha Sharma (<https://www.anuradhasharma.info/>), with a focus on Algebra and Number Theory.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Minimum 70% marks in both B.Sc. and M.Sc.
- Qualified for JRF (UGC/CSIR/NBHM/DST) or a GATE score of 450 or above

Application Process: Interested and eligible candidates should submit their applications directly via email to anuradha@iiitd.ac.in. Applications must include a detailed CV and all relevant supporting documents. Candidates are required to present original credentials (mark sheets, certificates, publications, research/professional experience, etc.) at the time of the interview. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Admission Process: Admission will be based on an interview, and candidates will be shortlisted for the interview based on their submitted credentials.

Financial Support:

- Institute Fellowship: Rs. 60,000 per month for 5 years for GATE-qualified students
- External Fellowships: Students joining with external funding (e.g., UGC, CSIR, NBHM) will receive top-ups to match the Institute's fellowship. That is, students on external support will also receive a fellowship of Rs. 60,000 per month.

Additional Benefits:

- Up to Rs. 50,000 for the purchase of a laptop/desktop
- Contingency grant of Rs. 20,000 per annum for students on Institute fellowship
- Financial support of INR 1.5 lakh for a two-week international lab visit
- Support to present research papers at national and international conferences
