The Visual and Media Arts Department is looking for middle school students interested in creating visual and/or media art! This may include a passion in drawing using graphite, charcoal, pastel, pen and ink; painting; using clay or plaster; and/or creating digital art, video or films, or photography.

To apply to the SDSCPA Middle School Visual & Media Art Department:

You will be participating in an artist workshop for your audition. Come prepared to share your passion for creating visual and/or media art.

In the workshop:

1. You may be asked to introduce yourself and answer some questions
 - Your first and last name
 - The grade you will be entering in the Fall
 - If you prefer to draw, do digital design, video production or photography
 - Why are you interested in attending SDSCPA?
 - Why do you want to be a Visual & Media Art Major?
 - What do you love about creating Art?
 - How would you contribute to a welcoming, inclusive, and collaborative class environment by actively participating in discussions, valuing different perspectives, and giving and receiving feedback respectfully?
2. During the workshop, students will participate in two hands-on activities: one digital and one focused on traditional observational drawing. You will participate in these activities as directed by your workshop teacher. You do not need to bring anything with you to do these activities.
 - Participation in the hands-on activities count as your audition
3. **OPTIONAL:** Show us some samples of your artwork!
 - You may bring 4-5 of your best works that you think will help us see the artist you really are
 - During the workshop activities, Visual & Media Arts teachers will review any art work you may have brought
 - Bringing work is not required

- Strong work ethic and commitment
