Language Apps

Here are some language apps you can make use of to learn the language and retain/refresh your memory:

- Duolingo: Duolingo is a gamified language-learning platform with courses in over 40 languages. It offers interactive exercises and a leveling system to keep learners engaged and motivated.
- Memrise: Memrise is a language-learning platform that utilizes mnemonic techniques and spaced repetition to help users memorize vocabulary effectively.
 It offers courses in multiple languages and incorporates multimedia elements to make learning engaging and memorable.
- Quizlet: Quizlet consists of various vocabulary sets and includes a flash card format for memorizing.
- Langster Includes reading short stories including voiceovers, and a read-along.
 Enables you to click on words to understand their meaning + has quizzes to test your knowledge.
- Babbel: Babbel is an online platform focused on practical language skills for everyday conversations. With courses in 14 languages, it provides interactive
- **Tandem:** tandem.net is an application for iOS and Android operating systems that connects language learners with native speakers. Members can search for

language partners and communicate with them via text and audio messages or video calls. There is a **free version** that you can make good use of!
