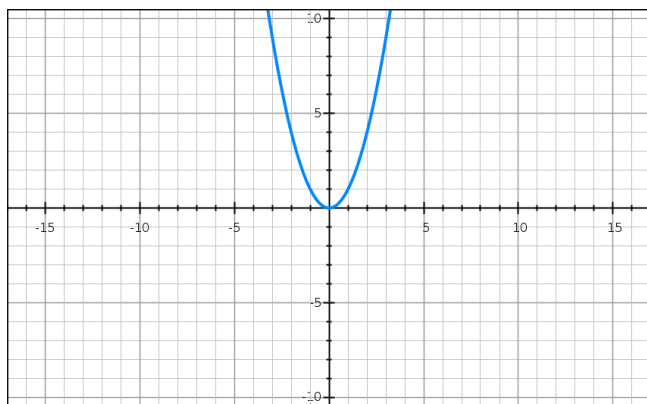


HE SAID/SHE SAID Quadratic Attributes

_____ The vertex of $f(x)$ is in quadrant 2

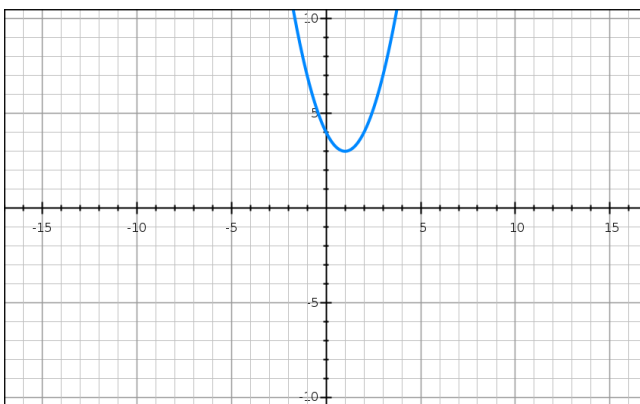
