

Code of Conduct Tilburg School of Social and Behavioral Sciences

2025-2026



The rules below apply to all members of the TSB faculty and its board members during all activities and on properties of both the Faculty Association and the (Study) Associations.

1. Mutual Respect

1. All participants are expected to treat one another with mutual respect;
2. All properties of the university and study associations will be treated with respect;
3. Disrespectful behavior, including discriminatory, racist, misogynistic, or sexist statements, is strictly prohibited;
4. Participants are expected to refrain from making harmful remarks (with intent) about other students and/or (study) associations. This will be monitored, reported and handled by the CCPs and the TSB board members when a claim has been made;
5. Any violations will result in consequences determined by the designated board of the association. The consequences will be determined by the severity of the broken rule.

2. Identification Requirements

1. Participants are required to carry a valid ID to all events hosted by IDEA and the (study) associations;
2. Failure to present a valid ID upon request will result in denial of entry to the activity. It is up to the IDEA board of 2025 - 2026 and the 2025 - 2026 boards of the (study) associations to actively enforce this.

3. Social Safety

1. Aggressive behavior, including verbal or physical violence, will not be tolerated;
2. Non-consensual intimacies or behaviors are prohibited under all circumstances;
3. Any violations for such behavior will result in denial of activities or other consequences determined by the board of the designated association during the academic year of 2025 - 2026.

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4. Prohibited Actions & Items

1. Excessive alcohol consumption is not permitted during IDEA activities and the activities of the (study) associations. Excessive alcohol consumption can be defined by being too impaired to act properly according to social norms and not being able to uphold responsibility;
2. Alcohol consumption under the legal drinking age in the Netherlands (18 years) is prohibited during IDEA activities and the activities of the (study) associations;
3. The use of soft or hard drugs is strictly prohibited during IDEA activities and the activities of the (study) associations;
4. Weapons of any kind are strictly forbidden at all during IDEA activities and the activities of the (study) associations;
5. Failure to comply with these rules will result in denial of activities or other consequences determined by the board of the designated association during the academic year of 2025 - 2026.

5. Compliance and Agreement

1. Participation in IDEA activities and the activities of the study association(s) are at your own risk;
2. IDEA, Complex, INPUT, POLIS, SCT, SPS-NIP and Versot are not responsible for theft, destruction, loss, or damages of a person's belongings at event locations or the board room(s);
3. By entering an IDEA, Complex, INPUT, POLIS, SCT, SPS-NIP or Versot event or location, participants agree to abide by these rules and regulations and have agreed to the code of conduct;
4. The IDEA board of 2025 - 2026 and the 2025 - 2026 boards of the (study) associations reserve the right to deny entry to any individual under valid and reasonable conditions. Decisions will be made and will be set if the majority votes in favor of doing so.
