Your child is currently enrolled in my **United States History** class for the **Fall** semester. This class is a college-bound course that can prepare your child for higher education. Additionally, this course is designed with a higher-level of thinking, reasoning and logic that will promote good study habits. Each class meeting will cover a different topic in American history, so it is essential that students are present to every class meeting and maintain a steady pace with the course material and classwork

#### **Overview**

Our course of study will begin with the American colonies and the growing anti-British sentiment that arose towards the motherland. We will analyze the American Revolution and the attempt by our forefathers to create "A more perfect union" for all. We will quickly cover themes regarding early American history (i.e., Manifest Destiny, Mexican-American War, Civil War, Reconstruction, Indian Wars, etc.) Our second course of study will cover the Industrial Revolution and the first major wave of immigration. We will cover the Progressive Era and the first real attempt to initiate democratic reform. Our third unit will cover American imperialism and the rise and role of the United States as a major world power. We will then shift focus to World War I and the United States' first major involvement in world affairs. Our fifth unit will look at the "Roaring 20s" and the social, political and economic advancements that came out of this era. While America was living a fanciful life, serious economic dilemmas lay ahead. Our final unit will look at the social-economic crisis that developed as a result of the Great Depression. We will finish by analyzing government's role and involvement in everyday affairs to solve problems.

## Class Requirements

Every student will need to purchase a <u>new</u> notebook which will be used to keep track of all of their assignments throughout the semester. They will be expected to keep it organized, neat and up to date. Notebooks will be turned in at the end of every unit; about every (4) weeks.
