

IN-TOWN GRAVEL RAMBLE

Drop (no sweeps) mixed terrain (road / gravel / singletrack) ride ~ 20 - 30 MILES

UPDATE: Ride is ON **Bring bright lights & warm clothes**
Helmets are mandatory, and cycling computers are highly recommended.

We're bringing gravel rambles back! The idea is to ride to the in-town gravel and singletrack. There will be a mix of roads, gravel, and sometimes singletrack. We will be riding in the dark until the Spring when the time changes, so it is necessary to have very bright headlights. The mileage won't seem like a lot, but we guarantee it will be tough (in a good way!).

We recommend a drop-bar style gravel bike with a minimum of 38mm tubeless tires. If you're not tubeless, you can ride, but jeez, go tubeless already \(\mathbb{\omega}\). You can run smaller tires but run the risk of flats. You can also ride a mountain bike, but it will be slow on the roads.
