We do not need the backstage workers or tech crew to attend this rehearsal.

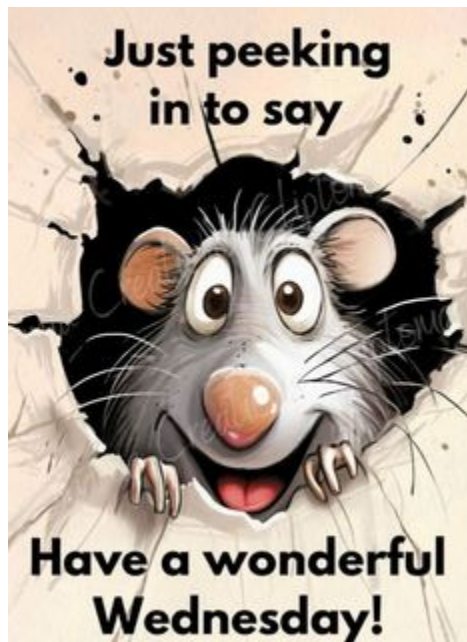

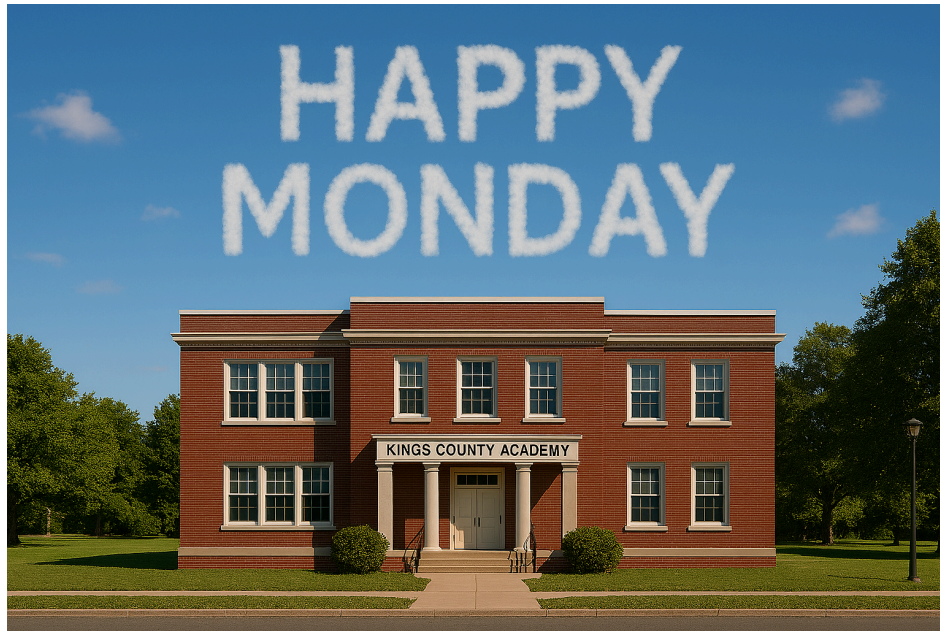
