Comfort food favorites on the menu include iron skillet cornbread, Wagyu meatloaf, and bourbon cherry chocolate bread pudding. Wines will be served with courses one through three, and a specialty sparkling cocktail will come with dessert. Dinner is \$75 per person, plus tax and gratuity, and will begin at 7 pm.

From the service to the food, everything was top notch. Steaks and other meats were cooked perfectly, and... Restaurant prices are coded using one to five dollar signs (or pounds — London reviews, euros — European reviews, yen — Japanese reviews). Prices reflect the average cost of dinner for one person, including appetizer, entrée, dessert, coffee, tax and tip.

Fall/winter appetizers include butternut squash, housemade herbed cashew cheese with torn baguette, and a wild rice and vegetable salad. A chili chocolate cake with vanilla ice cream proved an excellent choice. Kel declared the silky-smooth dessert her favorite of the year. Happy hour here is known as "Sparkling Hour" and gets you 50% off all bottles of sparkling wine and select appetizers. They also have three private dining rooms available for large groups. Entrees are priced from \$30 to \$50 and include housemade pasta, pan-roasted salmon, grilled duck breast, steaks, and sides.

This Southside spot is a newer addition to the Fort Worth Mexican food favorites. Come on Taco Tuesday's for \$3 tacos and one of their killer cocktails on the rooftop with stunning city views. Their lunch menu includes diner faves, like the Elvis sandwich, the tuna melt, or the "Stevie melt" – a grilled cheese with ham, bacon, and sausage.

Lucile's is a landmark family restaurant that serves traditional American food in a homey and historic setting. Their daily blackboard features fish specials that change daily. The menu is centered around "American Food Classics," popular American fare prepared from classic recipes updated to today's lifestyle.

There are also nice salads, pastas, and traditional burgers. Strolling around the restaurant and hotel is encouraged; tourists will certainly dig the hotel's Texana décor and architecture. Fort
