FOOD SECURITY



Lack of a secure food source is a primary cause of vulnerability among Africa's poorest children, driving many to incredibly dangerous survival practices. Young girls across Africa are daily selling their bodies just to secure a plate of food.

EDUCATION

Millions of orphaned and vulnerable children in Africa have no access to even primary education. Orphans are often forced to abandon school for a number of reasons: inadequate funds for school fees, caring for



sick family members or younger siblings, emotional distress, and discrimination. But education is the key to unlocking every child's God-given potential.

BASIC HEALTH CARE



Hands at Work in Africa improves the health of the most vulnerable through a suite of holistic activities delivered in the homes of sick and dying parents and of orphaned and vulnerable children. Come. Advocate. Pray. Give.

Subject: Toilets for Toyota Community

Hello my dear friends!

We have an exciting opportunity to bless the Community of Toyota with NEW TOILETS this year.

Hands at Work has identified the need to invest in infrastructure to better support a higher quality care of children and families. This year, for Toyota, there is a need to build proper toilet facilities on the Care Point property. The current toilets in Toyota pose a sanitary and safety hazard to the children in the community at the moment. Sickness and disease are rampant in this area, due to lack of accessible health care, medicine and poor sanitization and hygiene practices.

Knowing the physical, psychological and economic toll that open sewers takes on children and families, safe and clean toilets will be constructed for the children and Care Workers to use. There will be two separate toilets, one for the boys and one for the girls. All materials will be purchased locally, and local builders will be hired on for labour, as well as youth/young adults from the care point. The project will include: ensuring a deep enough hole is dug properly, cement flooring and walls, windows/pipes for adequate ventilation, and gate and lock for safety. Toilets will also be equipped with a hand-washing station where soap and hot water are provided to aid in good hygiene practices.

The total cost of this project is \$4,453 CAN and it is due to begin immediately. The deadline for donations is December 1st.
