

## **SENIOR MEDICINE POSTING/MEDICINE 3 POSTING**

The students are expected to have by now acquired the basic knowledge of most of the common systemic disorders in this posting.

He/ She is expected to consolidate this knowledge; and is encouraged to go into greater details to acquire more knowledge and skills.

### ***THE OBJECTIVES OF THE POSTING IN MEDICINE ARE AS FOLLOWS:***

1. The students should become expert in the detection and interpretation of abnormal physical signs.
2. He/she should be able to formulate a diagnosis, and to propose a logical plan of management based on his/her diagnosis (define the clinical problem in terms of function, structure and cause if possible.)
3. He/She should become competent in specified practical procedures.
4. He/She should learn the principles of treatment and relevant details of methods of treatment of common disorders.
5. He/She must complete a systematic study of selected medical diseases.
6. He/She should learn to work with other staff members, and to take other responsibility for some aspects of patients care.
7. He should understand the importance of social and geographical factors in the care of patients and the evidence of taking account of this.

### ***INSTRUCTION FOR STAFF AND STUDENTS:***

1. Students must register with the Departmental Secretary on the date of reporting.
2. Attendance at all lectures, emergency urgency teaching, tutorials and ward rounds/teaching is mandatory.
3. Students must clerk at least a patient/week. Patients clerked should be presented and discussed with consultants at ward teachings.
4. Students should ensure they carry out laboratory tests – blood stain for malaria parasites, urine microscopy, as appropriate.
5. Ward procedures like venipunctures, lumbar puncture, and insertion of IV lines, liver biopsies, either done or observed by students must be signed into the students' hand book by supervising consultant/resident immediately after each procedure.
6. Students should submit their hand book to the supervising consultants on the Wednesday of last week of posting. These will be used to compute continuous assessment.
7. Staff assessment forms must be filled immediately after lecture and submitted by the class rep to the departmental secretary.
8. All lectures must be given as planned by the timetable, lecturers should avoid pooling of lectures or staying too long in the class.
9. Bedside teaching should be given everyday and this should be in the clinics or wards and not in the offices or classrooms.
- 10. All visiting lecturers will give bedside teachings immediately after their lectures, 10.00am to 1.00pm**
11. Any student who is sick or traveling should communicate appropriately and submit a report as at when due.

#### ***NOTE:***

**Students are expected to participate FULLY in ALL aspects of clinical posting. FAILURE to fulfill AT LEAST 75% of the posting satisfactorily, disqualifies a student from taking the continuous assessment examination and subsequent final MBBS exam.**
