Parent/ Spectator Contract

As a parent, I understand it is my responsibility to:

- 1. Place academic achievement as the highest priority.
- 2. Show respect for our team and coaches, the opposing team and coaches, officials, and athletic department staff.
- 3. Refrain from negative comments about my child's coach in my child's presence so that I do not negatively influence my child's motivation and overall experience.
- 4. Engage in "no-directions" cheering, limiting my comments during the game to encourage my child and other players.
- 5. Use positive encouragement to cheer on my child and his/her teammates. I will not make negative comments to the opponent's players or coaches, nor the officials.
- 6. Model good sportsmanship for my athlete, as I know I represent my team and school.
- 7. Refrain from the use of alcohol, and profanity, vulgarity, or other offensive language and gestures.
- 8. Model a "win with character, lose with dignity" attitude.

As a parent, I understand CIF, CCAA and THS Spectator Rules as follows:

- 1. Parents/ spectators may not communicate with players.
- 2. When possible, spectators must not be closer than 100 feet from players and at no time should they be in front of the group they are following.
- 3. Spectators must not follow groups from the fairway but must follow via the rough whenever possible.
- 4. Violation of the spectator rule could cause disqualification of the player.
- 5. For the purpose of this rule, a golfer who finishes his/her round and returns to the course will be considered a spectator.
- 6. An initial warning will be given to all spectators at the beginning of the tournament and with every group that tees off.
- 7. Spectator use of golf carts is strictly up to the management of the golf course.
- 8. Practices are "closed" to parents, friends, or other non-school personnel, unless otherwise approved by the head coach.

As a parent, I understand that violations of these rules will be subject to the following penalties outside of CIF:

- 1. First offense will result in a warning.
- 2. Second offense will result in suspension from (2) matches.
- 3. Third offense will result in suspension from all remaining matches for the year.
