<u>Please bring your serger with you to class</u>. All brands of serger machines are welcome; however, we are most familiar with BERNINA machines and will be able to assist you if needed. If you have another brand of machine, please be familiar with how to thread it and bring your owner's manual for reference.

Supplies/Notions:

- (3) fat quarters quilting cotton (fabrics A, B, C)
- 1/3 yd. coordinating quilting cotton (fabric D) toe, heel, top ruffle
- 3 (12-weight) decorative threads** (2) 90/14 ELx705 serger or universal needles
- (1) 90/14 topstitch needle
- Lightweight fusible interfacing to stabilize the center panel
- ½ yd. lightweight fusible fleece (OESD Fuse 'n Fleece is great or your fave.)
- 6-inch length of ribbon for the hanger
- 4 cones serger thread
- Wash/heat away, marking pen or chalk
- Ruler
- · Rotary cutter and mat or scissors
- Pins or clips
- ** We have them available in our store for purchase. You can use 8WT as well or thread blend several colors together to create a unique look. You will want to use a *Thread Fusion* by Gail Patrice if you thread blend or combine several 12/8WT threads for the Fringe.

Optional: (but helpful)

- A clear presser foot makes following the drawn lines much easier (C27).
- 1/8" wide or 1/4" wide ribbons for weaving (or your choice of decorative fibers, yarn, etc)
- Bodkin or double-eye needle for weaving.
- Double sided basting tape.

- Starch for your fabrics REALLY helps out before cutting AND serging. I like Terral Magic or Odif.
- We will have irons available in class to use. You can bring your own if you prefer and a mat so you do not have to wait for others.

Prework:

PLEASE have your fabric cut-out before class. This will allow us to spend our time serging and give us time to finish the stockings.
