In the coming weeks, Frontier Academy's Middle School LULAC students will be hosting a "pulsera" sale to raise funds for Central American artisans. The Pulsera Project is a nonprofit organization that works with over 200 artisans in Guatemala and Nicaragua to sell beautiful, handwoven bracelets ("pulseras" in Spanish) as well as small "bolsitas" (purses).

You can pre-purchase any number of pulseras or bolsitas via [this cashless payment portal](#). You can pay via card, Venmo, Google and Apple Pay, or Paypal. Students can redeem pulseras with the receipt you'll receive after your purchase, or with cash during the sale. Please note that there is a \$0.50 transaction fee for all online transactions to cover service fees.

Each \$5 pulsera and \$15 bolsita sold will help create fair trade jobs, support communities in Nicaragua and Guatemala, and fund a number of [programs](#) that help improve the lives of hundreds of Central Americans.

Pulsera sales create sustainable jobs in vulnerable communities where there are few other options to achieve the dream of creating a better life for themselves and their families. By supporting our pulsera sale, you help keep families and communities together and in control of their own futures.
