Primary Purpose:

Assist the crew leader and crew members in getting schools/other support locations up to acceptable GISD conditions.

- Ability to properly install landscape materials and supplies
- Ability to complete all work orders and necessary paperwork
- Ability to do other duties as assigned
- Working knowledge of turf care and mowing

Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- 1. Assist mowing crews with mowing.
- 2. Ensure district locations are maintained in a presentable manner and provide quality care.
- 3. Operate all ground equipment (e.g., hand-held equipment, zero-turn mowers, skid loaders, and backhoes).
- 4. Install landscape materials and supplies.
- 5. Complete all work orders/job assignments and additional assignments.
- 6. Responsible for the truck and all equipment assigned, maintenance of the truck/equipment, and cleaning of debris daily.
- 7. Equipment upkeep is done daily (e.g., lubricating the unit, checking fluid levels).
- 8. Responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the entire rig (ex, truck, trailer, tractor, mowing deck).
- 9. Visually inspect the tractor for oil and water leaks, proper tire inflation, and overall condition, and report any deficiencies to management.
- 10. Perform all other duties as assigned.
