Parent Information

Communication that you should expect from your child's coach:

3. Team requirements, i.e. in-season and off-season
4. Discipline that results in the denial of your child's participation.

Communication Coaches expect From Parents:

1. Any concerns should be expressed directly to the coach of your son's team at an appropriate time (24 hour rule).
2. Notification of any schedule conflicts well in advance.

Appropriate Concerns to Discuss with Coaches:

1. Ways to help your child improve.
2. Concerns about your child's behavior.
3. Concerns about your child's academic progress.
