

"Submission Rules"

- 1. <u>/r/papillon</u> is not a platform for free advertising. Spammy posts to your blog/vlog/business/website/etc... or trying to Promote your papillon as a brand will be removed. More info here.
- 2. No NSFW submissions.
- 3. Posts should contain Papillon-related content in the link/post body. When posting pictures, we prefer you include some form of context to encourage discussion.
- 4. No URL shorteners (bit.ly, tinyurl, etc).
- 5. Respect others participating in the sub & maintain civil discourse. Discussion of food preferences, training techniques is fine, but avoid insult and mockery.
- 6. There is NO Rule Six! (Explanation)

Voting



Please review Reddiquette if you're not sure how voting is supposed to work on Reddit. (Or here's a quick annoying video: link.) There are millions of redditors that downvote for the wrong reason and you don't have to be one.

Basically, if you're voting on a post you should keep in mind what the reason for voting is suppose to be - upvote for a good relevant post, or downvote for a bad one. You may not agree with the opinions expressed but that isn't what downvoting is for. Why not express your opinion in the comments for why you disagree instead?

We are not trying to control your vote but please keep in mind, when someone posts a well thought out explanation of what they think, does it really deserve a downvote if you don't agree? What if someone downvoted you on a topic that you worked hard on?

It is just as easy to not vote at all. In our small subreddit, just one downvote can move a post off the front page and it can be a shame if someone put a lot of effort into something to have it dismissed so fast.

On the flipside, don't forget to upvote things that you like or like seeing. It can be easy to forget, especially when enjoying our favorite beverages.

Basically? Don't be a dick. Use the golden rule. It's suppose to be a free website for fun and you can help make it that. Help make the place great by voting appropriately.
