Week 4

- 1. Memorize verse 2 if you wish.
- Read a short history of the feast of Christ the King, and pray the "Act of Dedication of the Human Race to Jesus Christ King" (Note: in the Extraordinary Form, this feast is celebrated on the last Sunday in October, while in the Ordinary Form, it falls on the last Sunday before Advent.)
