English: 4.0 credits

Financial Literacy or Personal Finance: 0.5 credit

Freshman Success: 0.5 credit

Health: 0.5 credit

Math: 3.0 credits

Physical Education: 1.5 credits

Science: 3.0 credits

Social Studies: 3.0 credits

Electives: 10.0 credits

Academic & Career Plan (ACP): Students are required to complete an ACP during their 4-year high school career. More information on this can be found on the Rice Lake High School Website.

Students should sign up for any required courses they have failed, even if they plan to take Summer School.

Note: Study Hall requests can be made after schedules are completed. Students are limited to one Study Hall per year.

ENGLISH:

- English 11 and an English Elective ENxxxx and ENxxxx OR
- AP English Language and Composition EN0443 and EN0444

MATH:

- Most four-year colleges require students to complete **Algebra 1, Geometry and Algebra 2** as **minimum** Math preparation. **Introductory Geometry** does count toward the 3-credit Math graduation requirement but does not take the place of the Geometry requirement for four-year college purposes.

PHY ED:

- Students must choose a **minimum** of one term of Phy Ed during their Junior or Senior year. Athletic Training and Senior Assist **will not** count toward the 1.5 Physical Education credits needed to graduate.

SCIENCE:

- Students who opted out of IPS Physics and IPS Chemistry and completed Biology 1 and Biology 2 need to complete Chemistry (1 credit) and Physics Blue and Gold (1 credit) at some point during high school. It is your responsibility to check with colleges for other possible Science requirements.

SOCIAL STUDIES:

- Students must choose either World History or AP European History for 11th grade. Each course meets for two terms. **World History SO5301 & SO5302 or AP World History: Modern SO5901 & SO5902**

POST-SECONDARY ADMISSIONS PLANNING NOTE: It is your responsibility to check with colleges regarding specific admissions requirements. In addition to the bullets below, other schools may have other requirements.

- The U of MN requires 1.0 credit of visual/performing arts (music, art) and 2.0 credits of World Language.
- UW Madison highly recommends 2.0 credits of the same World Language to fulfill the World Language requirement as a student at UW Madison.

EARLY GRADUATION

1. The student and their parents are strongly encouraged to fill out the Request for Early Graduation form prior to the completion of their junior year.
2. The student must meet all of the school's graduation requirements.
3. The student must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 for 12 terms and maintain that average through 14 terms.
4. The student must show evidence of plans for full-time involvement in school or work.
5. The student must be in attendance a minimum of 14 terms.
6. A screening committee will review the request and approve or disapprove the request.
7. A student who graduates early will receive their diploma at the regularly scheduled commencement exercises.
8. In unusual circumstances, the principal may review problems associated with grade point averages, semesters of attendance or health, and approve or disapprove requests on their individual merit.
