


Shopify vs. Wix: Which is Better for Ecommerce in 2022?



Shopify vs. Wix: What's the Pricing?



We give an upper hand to Wix when it comes to pricing. Wix offers a basic plan to users, which is free. Though it has limited functions, it's good to start with your website.

While Shopify only offers 14 days of a free trial, and after that, you will have to pay \$29 monthly.

If we compare both platforms in terms of being expensive or cheap, Shopify is still quite costly.

Wix offers a good website for \$29 to \$50 a month, while with Shopify, you pay \$29 to \$200 a month.

So, Wix is the winner here. It offers you a good website at low prices. Shopify works out to be expensive when comparing the price of their plans with Wix.

Transaction and Credit Card Fee Comparison:

Wix wins here too. It doesn't charge any fee for processing transactions. It is free of cost for all users.

On the other hand, Shopify charges 2% - 3% if you choose any payment gateway other than Shopify Payment.


However, both platforms charge credit card processing fee, which is as below:

If you use Wix Payments: Fee is 2.9% + 30c in the US

If you use Shopify Payments: **Fee is 2.4% to 2.9%**. The fee also depends on the type of plan you have.

Also, Shopify limits the members who can manage the store while Wix allows unlimited members to manage it. However, there is no setup fee involved to use both platforms.



Templates and Design




On the other hand, Wix offers a custom-built platform to its users. This means that it only provides a basic framework, and the rest is up to you.

You can also add the feature to the check-out form, making it optional or mandatory a better option to track customers. Wix only can track customers but doesn't have any other functionalities.



Blogging Feature:







Blogging lets you scale your business and reach more customers. It also helps you maintain your followers on social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, and Google Plus.

Both the platforms have native apps. Wix's app is called <u>Wix owner</u> and has a better rating and functionality than Shopify App.








Wix App Market vs. Shopify Store: Which is Better?

While using Wix, you can only use their CMS, which is slightly difficult for non-technical users to create good quality content in a short time.


On the other hand, Shopify provides you with a variety of CMS tools that helps create and modify content fast and easily. You can also get more resources from their store to create content.
