

5. First draft of the HL Essay

You are going to write the first draft of your HL Essay in class by hand, without text-editing software or AI (like ChatGPT). We will take 3 lessons to do this. This first draft will remain in the classroom between lessons. You may bring the following items to this 'exam'.

- A printed **outline** (see previous activity) of no more than 600 words. This word count includes quotations (of primary and secondary sources) and your line of inquiry.
- a pen
- paper

Write double-spaced to make the feedback and editing process more manageable. Re-read your first draft before submitting it. You will receive another lesson to complete the self-assessment form on the following page. You can use your teacher's feedback to complete the final draft, digitally, for Activity 6: Final copy of the HLE. For your record, take photos of your essay after your teaching has written on it and provided you with (video) feedback.
