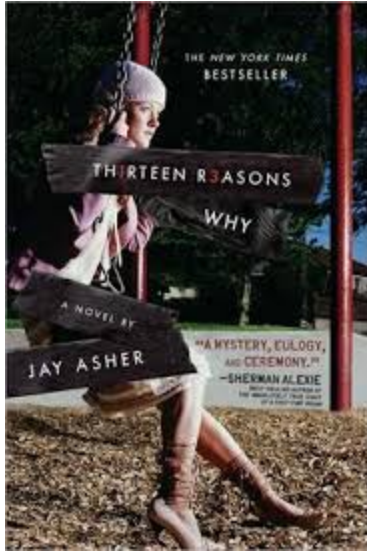

Hannah Baker, a high school girl who ended her own life, wanted the people who caused her to kill herself to know why she did it. So she makes 13 tapes and records one tape to each person who played a role in her death. Then, she mails these tapes out for people to listen to them.
