

World condition:

- Space planet parasite, attached to Antarctica
- Earth's tectonic plates are now closer to each other because the tectonic theory were proven to be right. Now contains 3 major continents. Phanes, Penia, Janus.

Government system:

- Earth is now governed by one authority. 'One-government'
- Every continent has 'Advodem'
- And only one 'Advodem in chair'
- There can only be 5 Advodem in each continent at a time.
- The status of Advodem is forever ingrained on a person's name, as being Advodem is a commitment. An Advodem cannot resign.
- Status is only stripped when; an Advodem died, or replaced via the Annually survey of One-government. The oldest running Advodem will be discarded of the position when a new Advodem is elected.
- And lastly. Being Advodem is not a 'job'. Referring to the position as 'occupation' nor anything remotely close to 'work' is detained. 5 years maximum.

Qualifications:

- There are qualifications to be an advodem
 - served its own continent for at least 5 years.
 - elected by people
 - And went through the 'initial process'.
- Qualifications of 'Advodem in chair'
 - Served their own continent for atleast 5 years
 - elected by people
 - and went through the 'Second-process'
 - Acted the 'ultimatum agenda' of the One-goverment;
 1. Swore an oath to the republic of new earth
 2. Judged by the 17 high seats of the One-goverment. Via voting.
 3. Has the 'ultimate approval' of at least 3 least advodem of the origin continent of the contender.

Initial process:

- The only way to crawl up to the ladder of being an advodem is through 'self appointed commitment.' Meaning helping the said continent. Such as Public service, and anything related to helping the continent.

- And there's no other way to be an advodem, except people's elections. Annually, the One-government will have a world wide survey on who should be the next new advodem of their own continent.
- Every continent can only have 2 Advodem contenders. Which will be picked from the 2 highest elections based on the survey.
- And finally, for a new 'Advodem' to be seated in the 'chair of decision', a debate will be held at one of the One-government facilities.
- The two picked contenders for the 'Chair of decision' of every continent will be at a separate room. There, the room will be surrounded by camera's, a truth seeking person, and a judge. For anyone to win a debate, the contender shall have the vote of The judge AND the truthseeker inside that room.
- If each contender has the vote of either of the judge or the truth seeker the debate is brought to a 'reset' and the judge will give another topic.
- The amount of 'reset' there can be in a debate session, is only 7. If in the 7th round, The judge and The truthseeker still has their vote separated into each of the contenders, there will be a next round, but it won't be called an 8th round. It must be called 'new 7th'.
- The 'new 7th' round will have a pointing system. And they won't be debating anymore, instead they would be asked a numerous amount of questions by the truthseeker about any given topic by the judge. And whoever got the most right answers, will be converted into points. And whoever has the most, will be elected as the new 'Advodem' of their own continents.

Second-process:

- After an 'Advodem' is elected via debate or 'new 7th' the elected does not get the 'Chair of decision' right away. As there will be a process of judgement by the 17 high seats of the One-government.
- The judgement works as follows:
 - After a contender win the session, a date will be given to them. And on that day they will go to the 'humble circle'. In which the Advodem will introduce themselves, and the reason why he thinks the people elected him as an 'Advodem'.
 - After that, the Advodem must remain silent, with their hands either behind their back, or in front of their laps. Any other hand placement is considered 'taboo'. If this 'taboo' is intentionally acted, the Advodem is automatically disqualified, and the next contender is given the 'Chair of decision', forthwith.

- While being silent, the 17 high seats will talk to each other to give the final verdict.

= If the final verdict shows that the high seats are in favor of the Advodem, only then the Advodem can speak their words of appreciation and acknowledgement. In which after that, they will be given the right to the 'Chair of decision' via granting 'blessing' to the Advodem in which the Advodem must kneel with one knee to the ground and bow their head to the level of their other knee. After the 'blessing' only then, any formality is broken and the Advodem can leave the Humble circle.

= If the final verdict shows that the high seats are against the Advodem. The said Advodem wont be granted the 'Chair of decision', and The 'Chair of decision' is given to the most recent alive Advodem. The Advodem is to left with a bow and expressions of gratefulness. Without breaking the formality.

Definitions:

- Chair of decision; The name called the seat of place given to an 'Advodem'. It's the status the gives them power over their continent, in which they will be called 'Advodem in Chair'. The Chair of Decision is a place. And once the Advodem is officially selected. The Advodem has the right to choose where to establish his Chair of decision.

- The truthseeker; The person inside a debate session that questions the validity of the said statement of a contender. Doesn't matter if the statement is factually proven nor wrong. The truth seeker has the power to question it. For an instance— the contender states that ' $2+2=4$ ', which is factually correct. But the truthseeker can ask if it's right or wrong.

|• There's only 2 way to respond to the truthseeker's question. Either to explain, or to admit.

1. Explain; To explain the statement.

2. admit it's wrong or the contender does not know anything further than the statement.

- The judge; The Judge verifies the answer of the contender to the question of the truthseeker. Other than that, The judge gives the topic to the 2 contender and knows all the facts and lies within the topic. Any new argument brought to the said topic will have to be recorded by the Judge and use their own objective perspective to evaluate the new argument.

- New 7th: Referred to the extra round of the debate session

- One-government: The Authority of the entire planet.

- Advodem: person who was given the power to advocate for their continents.

! Plural form— 'Advodemos'

- Ultimate approval: The approval of anyone. Usually a statement via letter or witnessing.
- Ultimatum Agenda: The steps of action to commit to the One-government, Only done by high seats, or Advodemos.
- Initial process: The first process in becoming an Advodem. A crucial and necessary step.
- Second-process: The next and last process, done only by those attempting 'Advodem in Chair'.
- 17 High seats: The high seats which resides on the One-government's humble circle. People who are seated here are people who came from families that held the seats. Each family held one seats. And only offspring from their families shall inherit the seats and continue to run the One-government.
- Humble circle: Acts like an office, where the high seats presides. This is where judgement, meetings, decisions, and plans are made.
- Reset: The term used when the debate is going to start again.
- Judgement: The discussion of the 17 high seats and their votes casting towards the Advodem.
- Final verdict: The results of the Judgement.
