Scheduling Online Sessions:



Click the above link to schedule tutoring in any of the following subjects: Accounting, Biology/Anatomy & Physiology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, History, Math, Nursing, Physics, Political Science, Spanish, Sociology, Psychology. Students need to be enrolled in a class in order to schedule tutoring for that subject. The default appointment length is 30 minutes. If a student wants a full hour of tutoring, please call us at (847) 214-7256 to reserve that time. If a student still has questions after a full hour of tutoring and the tutor is still available, the tutor can choose to extend the session an additional half hour.

[Write Place Appointment:](#)

Click the above link to schedule an appointment with the Write Place. Any students looking for help related to reading, writing, English, or English as a Second Language (ESL) can make an appointment at the Write Place. Students can schedule appointments at the Write Place for any writing task they are working on, including scholarship essays and four-year transfer applications. The default appointment length is 30 minutes. If a student still has questions after a half hour and the tutor is still available, the tutor can choose to extend the session an additional half hour. On the sign-in page, use your student username and your birthdate to log in. Student usernames are your first initial, last name, and the last four digits of your student ID.

Please limit yourself to one scheduled appointment per class per day. All online appointments are one-on-one, and are conducted through Zoom. Online tutoring is available up to seven days a week, depending on your class. Limited in-person tutoring appointments are available through this schedule as well. The Tutoring Center also has drop-in tutoring available on campus up to six days a week. No appointments are necessary for drop-in tutoring, and students can come as often as they want and stay as long as they need. 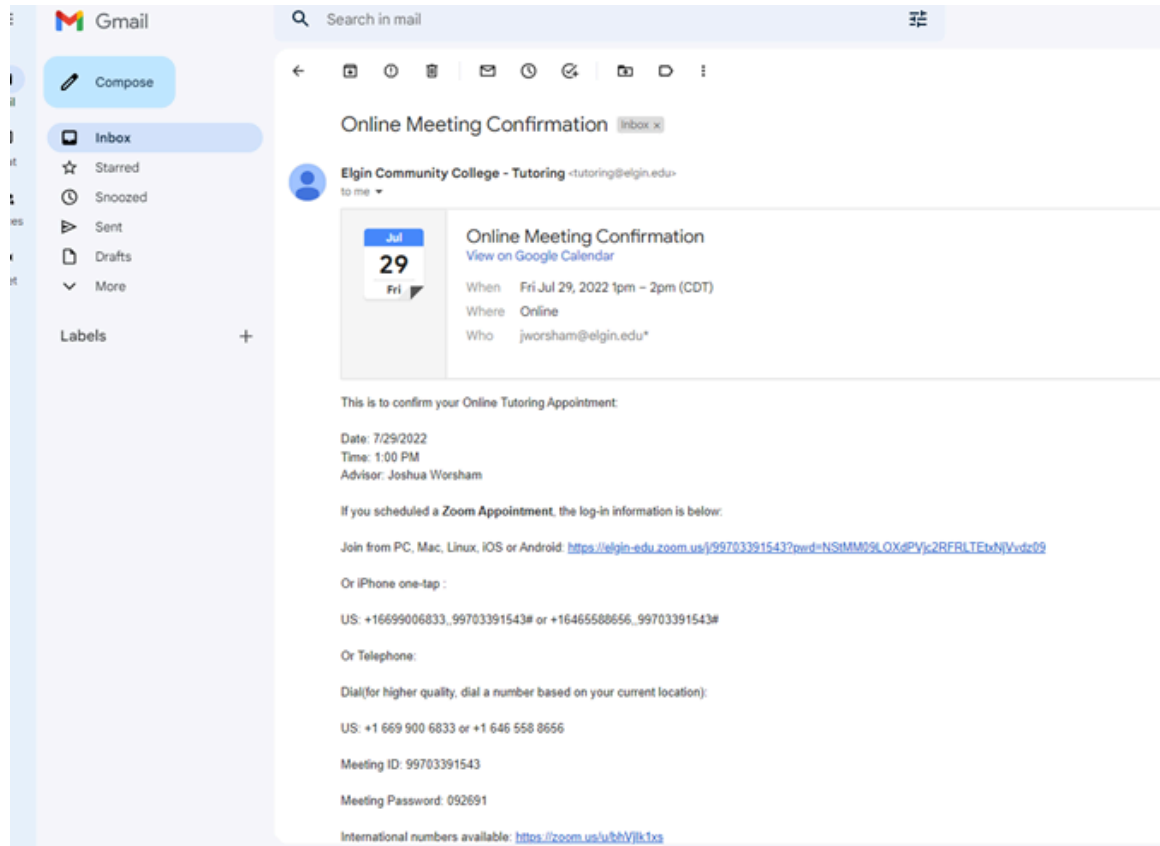

Please limit yourself to one appointment per day, per subject. Live online sessions are available up to seven days a week during the fall and spring semesters, up to four days a week in summer. On campus tutoring is available up to six days a week during fall and spring, and up to four days a week in summer. Sessions listed as On Campus can be reserved online, and the location of the session will be noted in your confirmation email. Students are also encouraged to drop-in for tutoring with no appointment: Tutoring Center, Room C230; Write Place, Room B274.

Students can cancel appointments by logging into the scheduling system and clicking "View or Cancel Appointments" on the main menu screen or by calling the Tutoring Center at (847) 214-7256.

If you have chosen an online appointment, you will receive a confirmation email with the link to your Zoom tutoring session.



At the time of your session, open the Zoom link to meet with your tutor. If you do not receive an email with the Zoom link, please contact us at (847) 214-7256.

As with all technology, problems may occur. Our tutors will adapt to the situation and do everything they can to answer your questions. We suggest preparing your computer or mobile device for your session a few minutes ahead of time to deal with any connection issues so it doesn't cut into your time with a tutor.

Drop-In Tutoring:

Drop-in tutoring is available up to six days a week, depending on the subject. Students can come as often as they want and stay as long as they need. No appointment is necessary for drop-in tutoring. 
