Who We Are:

GWL's mission and operations are premised on the understanding that environmental conditions are inextricably linked to the economic and social health of a neighborhood. Therefore, GWL is committed to "changing places, changing lives, changing systems" through on-the-ground projects that help transform local communities.

What You Will Do:

Urban Adventures Summer Program is a 5-week summer youth program designed to provide children with a fun-filled summer camp-like experience within the heart of Lawrence while promoting social-emotional learning, environmental stewardship, sustainability, nutrition, academic excellence, team building, creative expression, and regional exploration. Groundwork Lawrence is working in partnership with community-based organizations and Lawrence public schools to administer this program. Urban Adventures is designated for youth ages 11-14. Youth will investigate healthy food access, sustainability, and/or environmental stewardship in the Lawrence community and create service-learning projects to promote positive change and community learning on these topics. All programming will adhere to and follow CDC guidelines for a safe and healthy summer experience.

Groundwork Lawrence (GWL) is seeking a responsible, intelligent, creative young adult, **16 years or older** with a passion for working with Lawrence youth indoors and outdoors, to hire as a Junior Counselor for the 2025 season. The **Junior Counselor will assist in the delivery of service-learning and related topic instruction, guidance, and supervision of youth in accordance with programmatic goals** as well as health and safety regulations as mandated by partner organizations and the state. There will also be a mandatory training period and some curriculum development before summer programming begins. This is a seasonal paid position with a maximum of 18 hrs./wk. Below is a sample of the job responsibilities required for this position. Changes to and additions to such responsibilities may occur depending on the needs of the program.

Job Responsibilities:

- Participate in a week-long, paid training prior to the beginning of the program on topics including but not limited to service learning, social-emotional learning, and program curriculum.
- Assist your Senior Counselors in delivering program activities, lessons, instruction, and games including but not limited to gardening, nature explorations, science experiments, cooking, games, arts/crafts, & technology.
- Adhere to all CDC guidelines and expectations in the prevention of illnesses.
- Maintain safety of children and youth by adhering to program and partner policies, rules, and procedures.
- Serve as a mentor and role model for youth participants.
- Be available to work for the entire duration of the season and adhere to daily schedule.
- Collaborate with the other counselors (junior and senior) for program planning, curriculum development/adjustment, and implementation.
- Complete weekly check-ins to record overall experience, challenges, and successes.

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Qualifications:

- Minimum of 16 years of age, US citizen or permanent resident status.
- Have an interest in working with youth, environmental education, community engagement, healthy food access, cooking, science, urban agriculture, and/or the outdoors.
- Successful and satisfactory completion of a background check, both Criminal and Sexual Offender Record Information.
- Access to the internet.
- Ability to participate in physical activities, including extensive walks, garden activities, and sports.
- Ability to work effectively independently and as part of a team.
- Experience or desire to work in multicultural settings.
- Strong communication skills.

Desired Qualifications:

- Have experience working with youth in-person or outdoors.
- Bilingual in English and Spanish.
- CPR/First Aid certified.
