

### Research Interests:

My research examines the power of stories to connect people, shape understanding, and convey cultural messages across time. I explore how narratives evolve and how they influence teaching, learning, and identity within and beyond formal education.

Through my podcast *Classroom Caffeine*, I investigate podcasting as a medium for research dissemination, translating scholars' stories into accessible conversations for practitioners and the public. I also study storytelling through children's literature—especially Lewis Carroll's *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*—analyzing words and illustrations to reveal layered narratives and historical significance. My work integrates technologies such as Extended Reality to explore new ways of knowing and understanding the world. Using creative qualitative methodologies, including time-lapse photography and curation, I analyze complex data sets to uncover hidden narratives.

Across all projects, my goal is to democratize access to knowledge by leveraging transdisciplinary approaches that deepen our collective understanding of cultural connections within stories, both told and untold.
